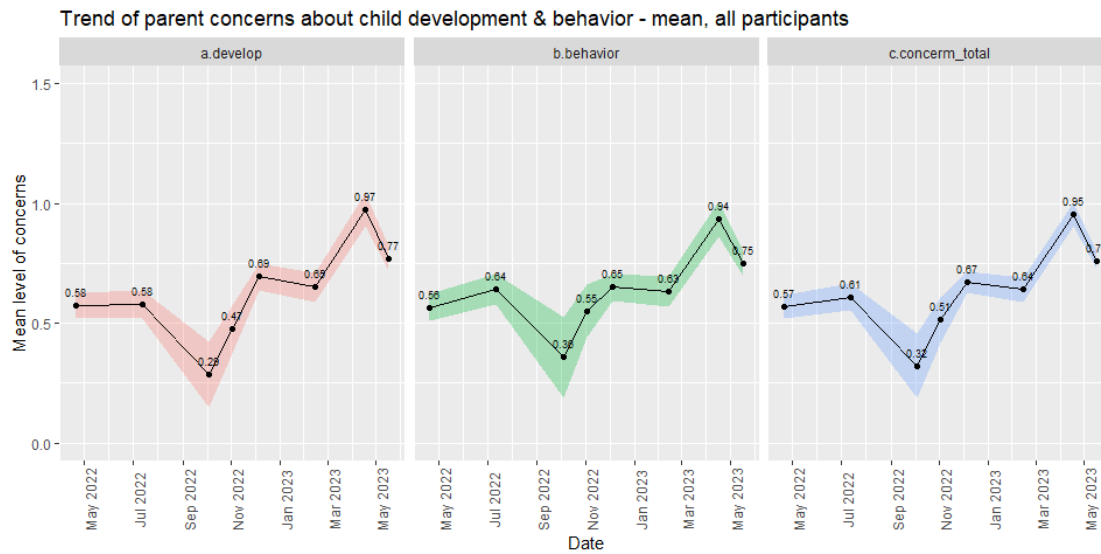
Survey question:

- Note: individual scores (i.e., “develop” & “behavior”) and average scores of the two items (i.e., “concern total”) were used in analyses

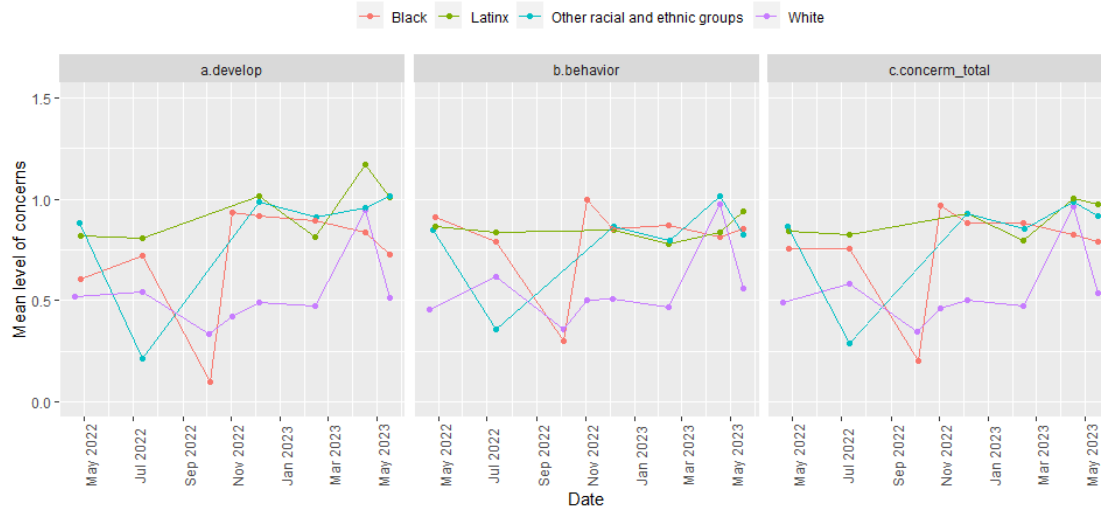

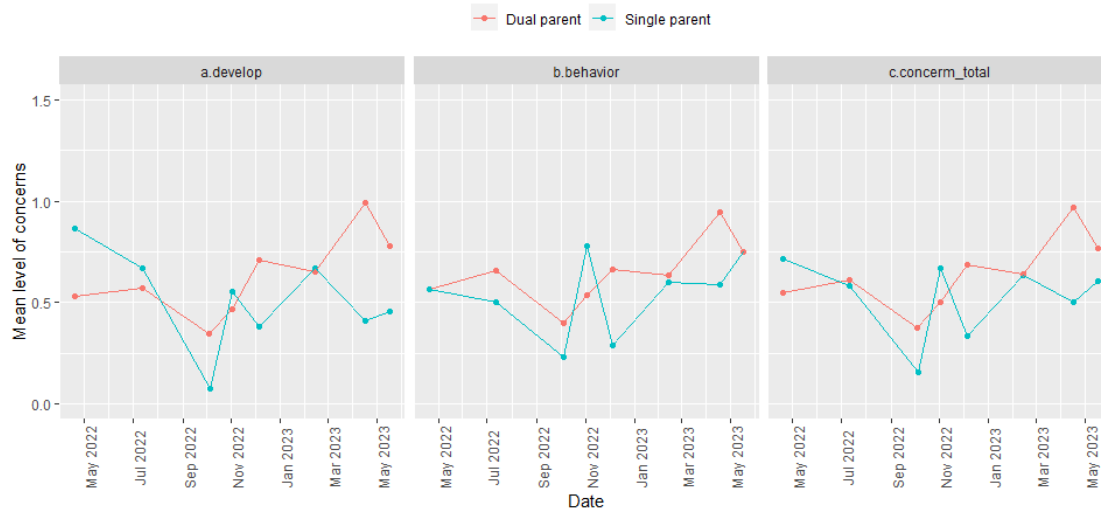

Trend of parent concerns about child development & behavior - mean, by race/ethnicity



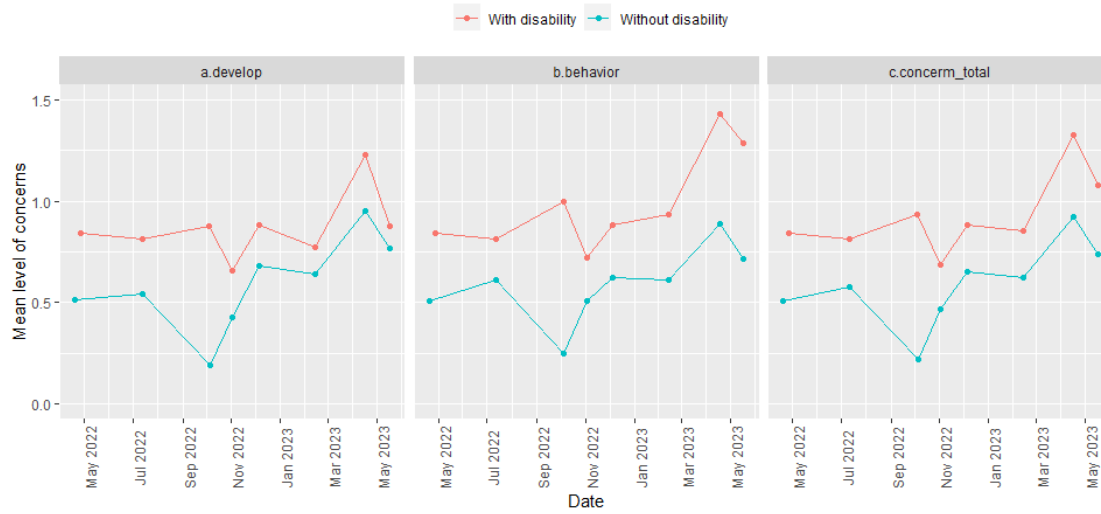

Trend of parent concerns about child development & behavior - mean, by single-parent status



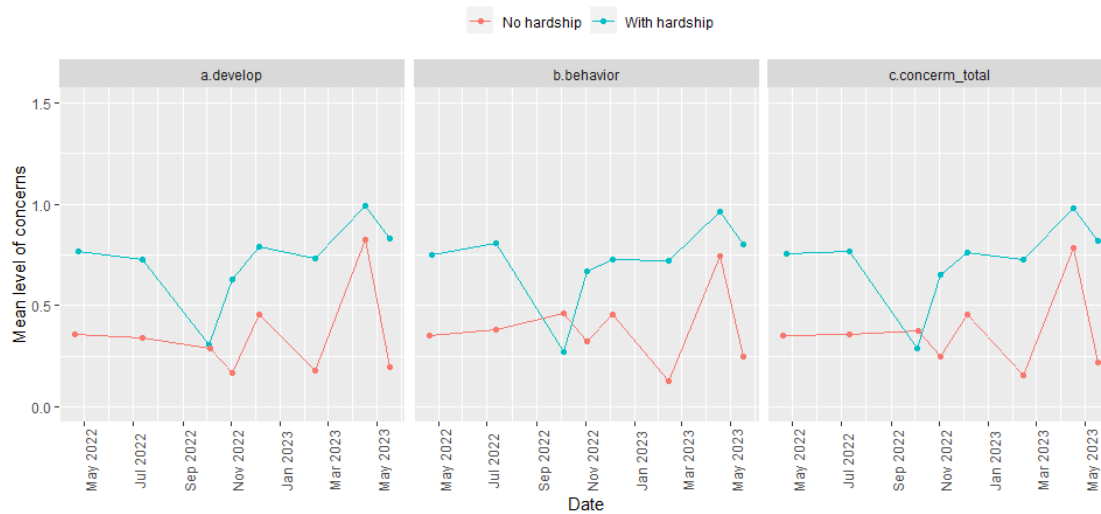

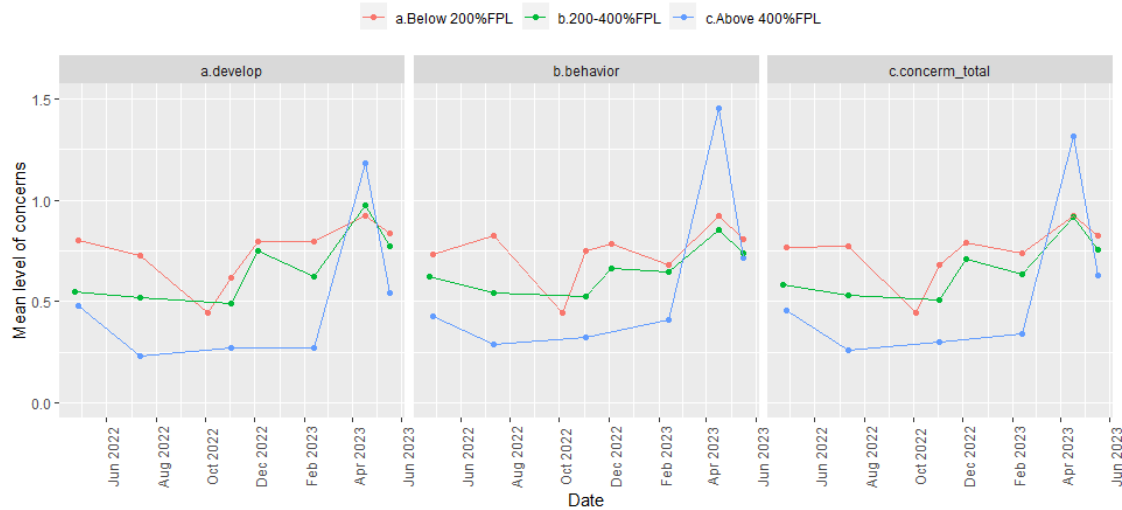
Trend of parent concerns about child development & behavior - mean, by material hardship status

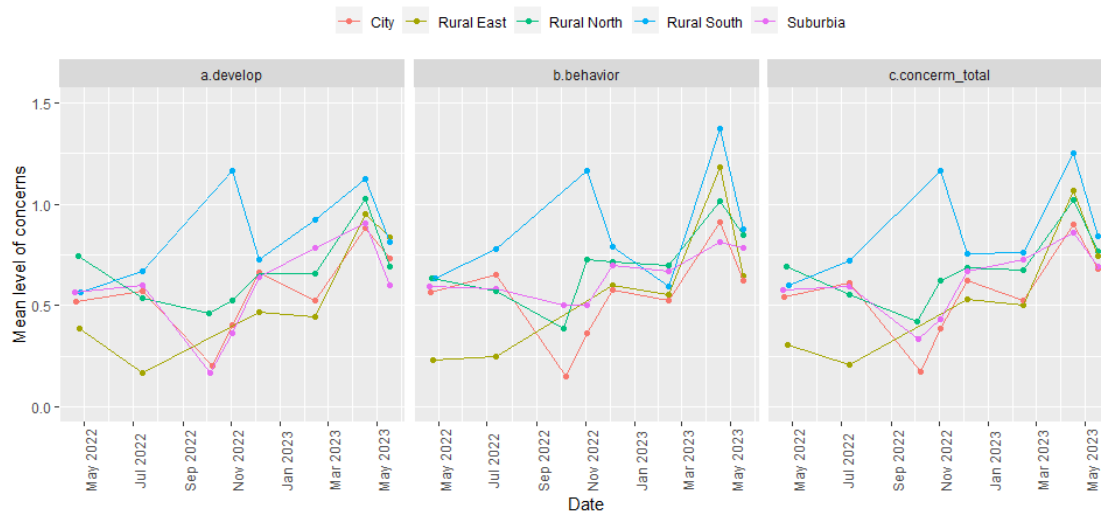
Trend of parent concerns about child development & behavior - mean, by income levels

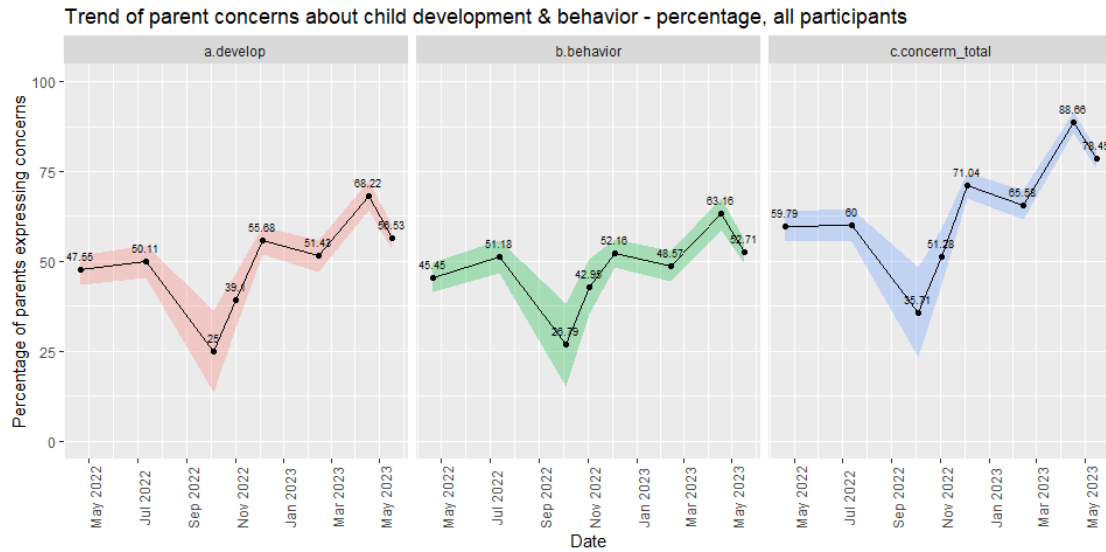
Trend of parent concerns about child development & behavior - mean, by community types

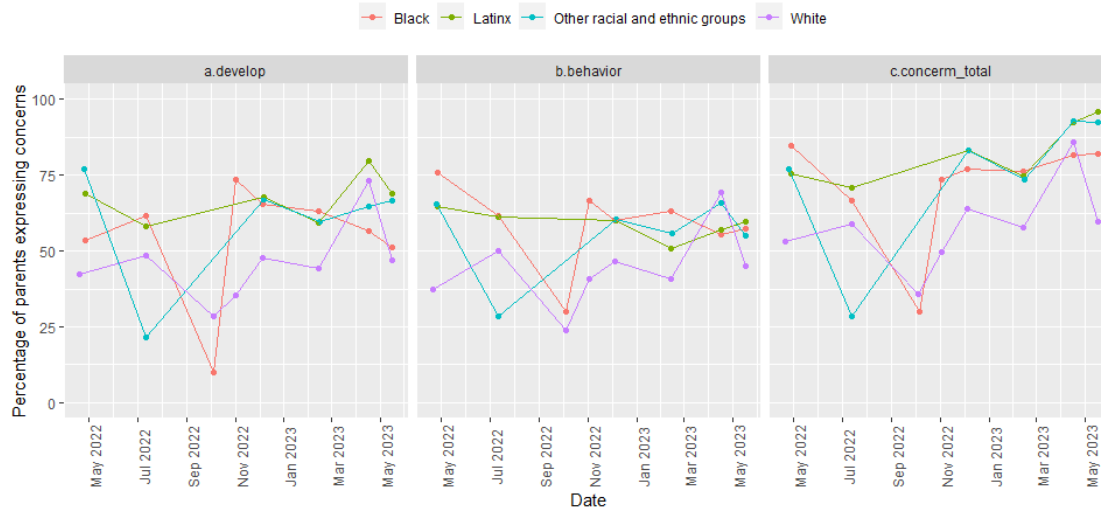

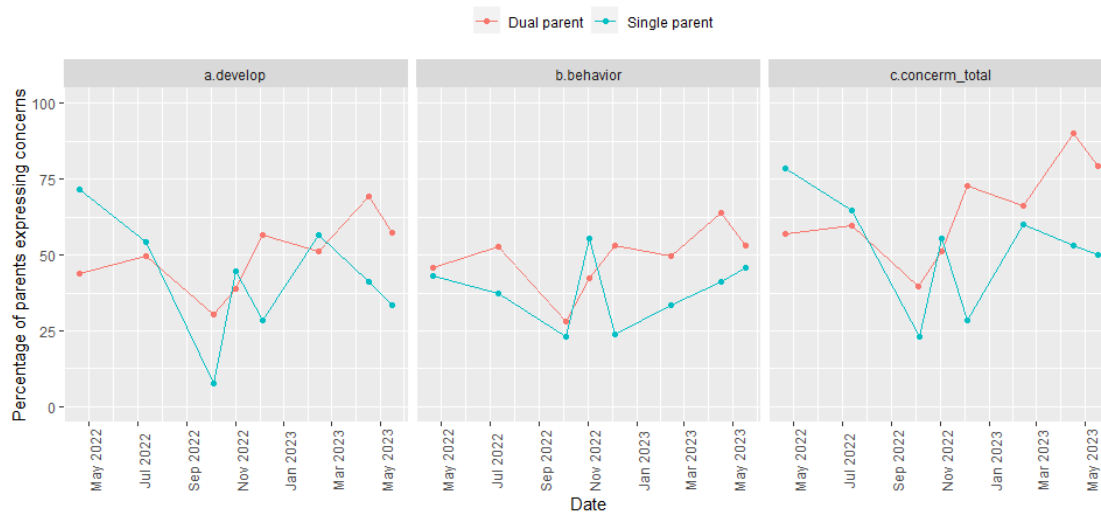

Trend of parent concerns about child development & behavior - percentage, by race/ethnicity



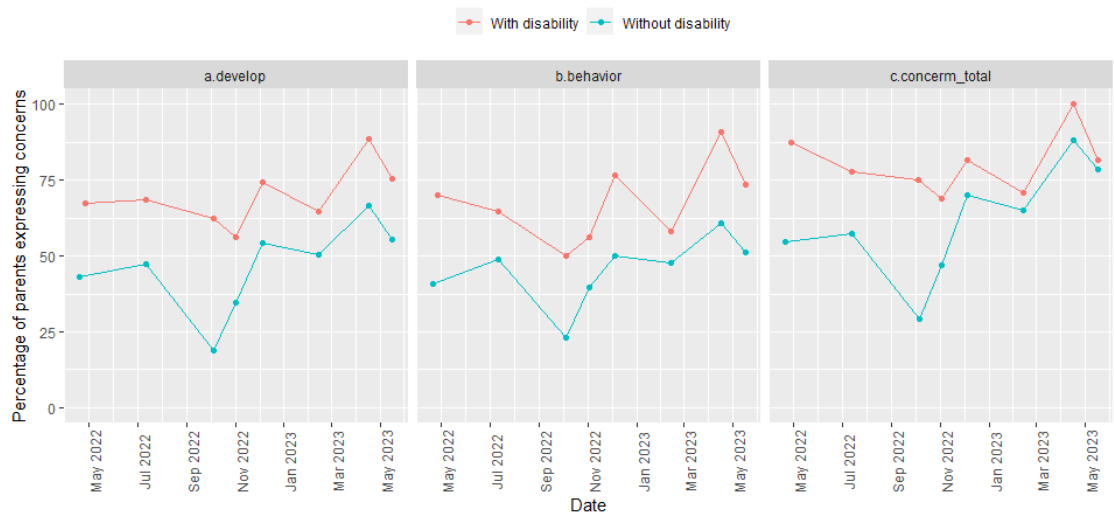

Trend of parent concerns about child development & behavior - percentage, by child disability status



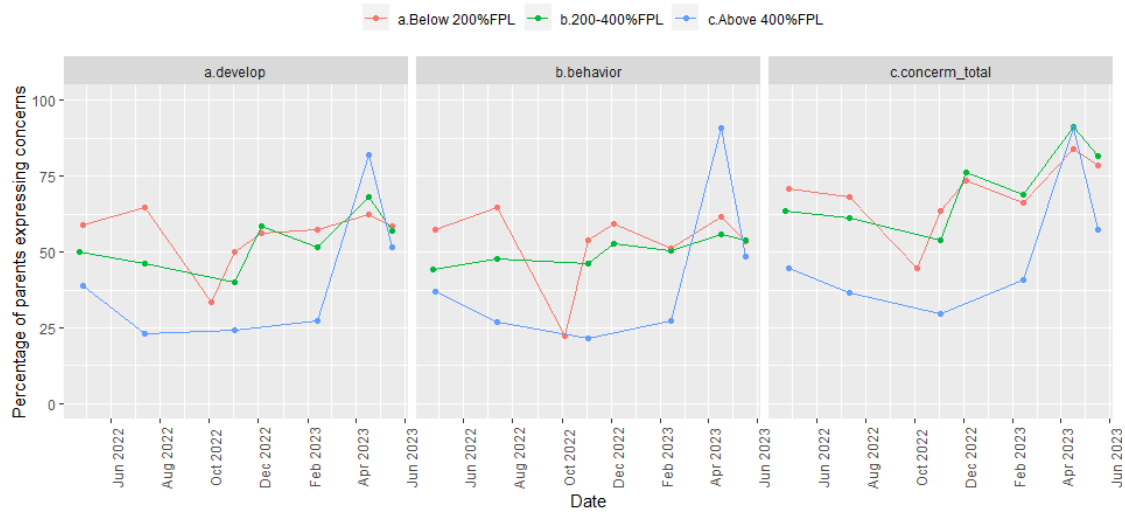
