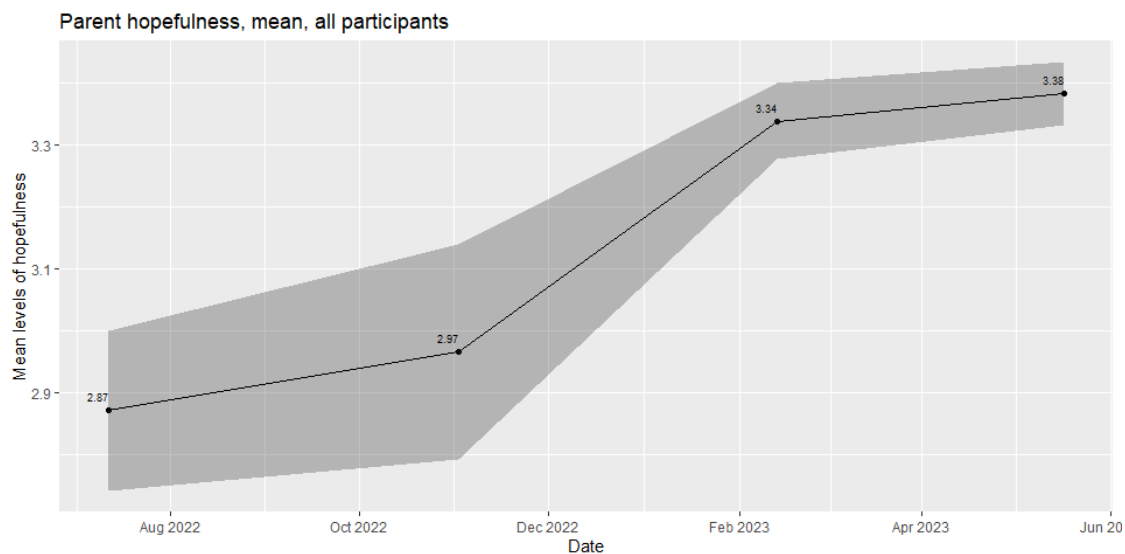
Survey question: In the past week, please describe how often... - I felt hopeful about the future

- 4 - Most or all of the time (5-7 days)

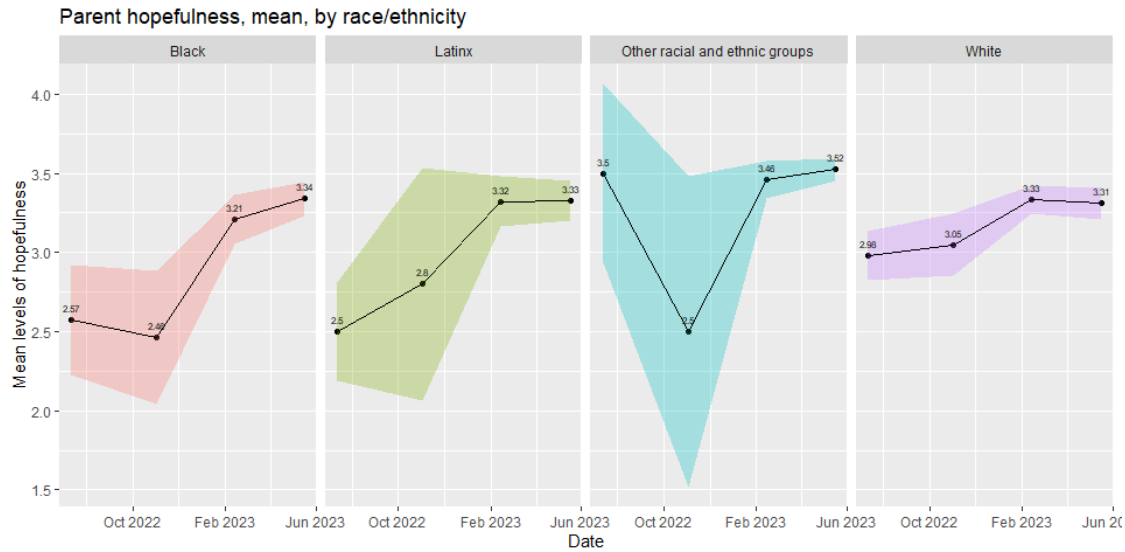

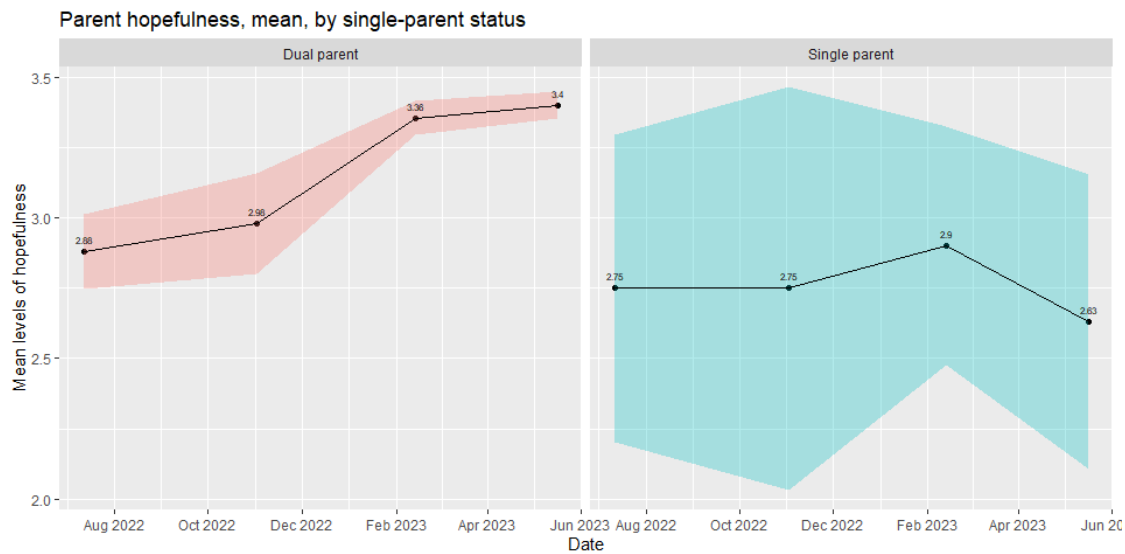

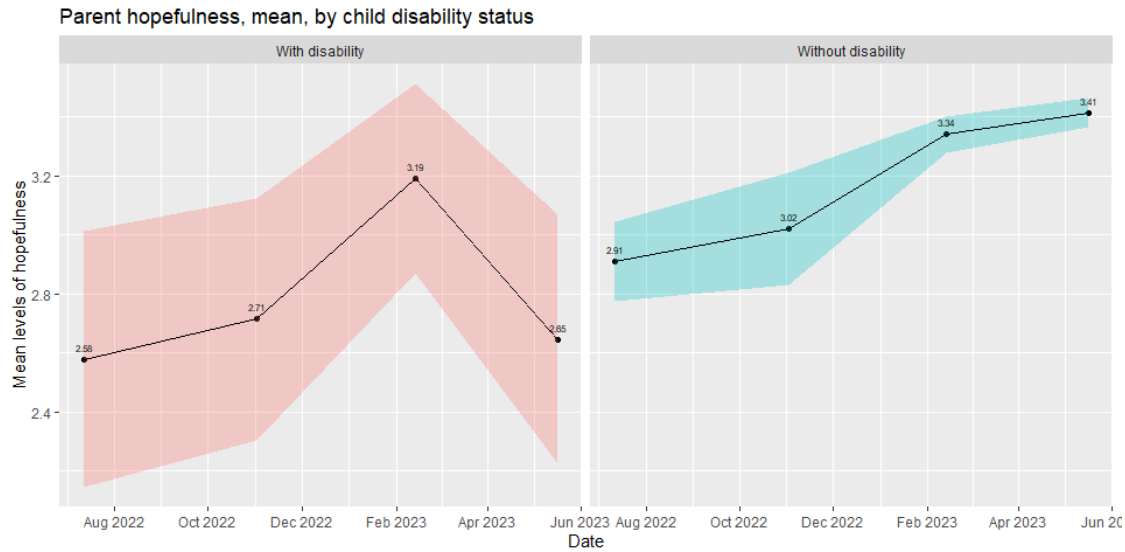

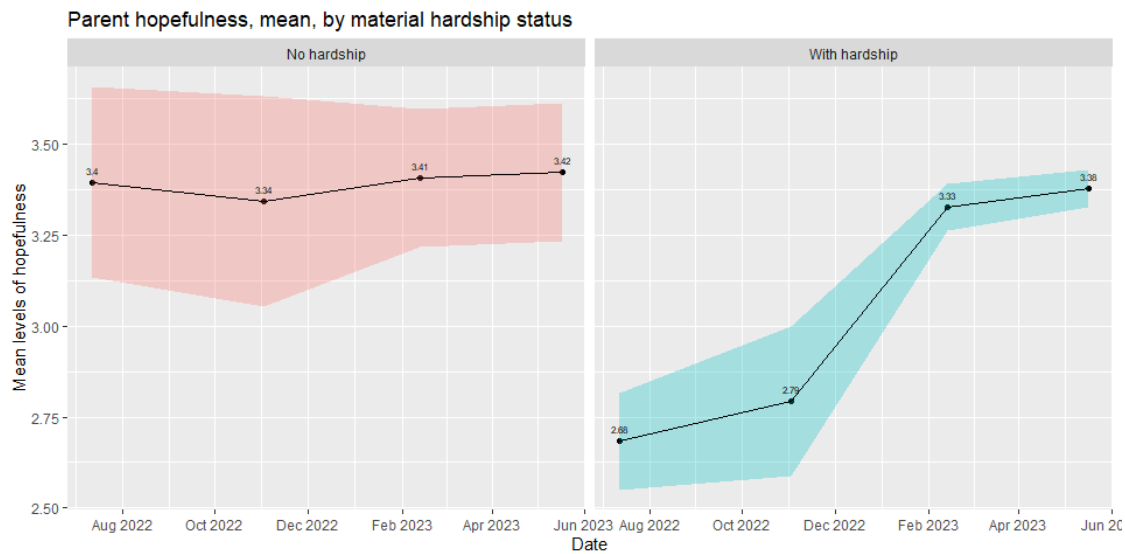

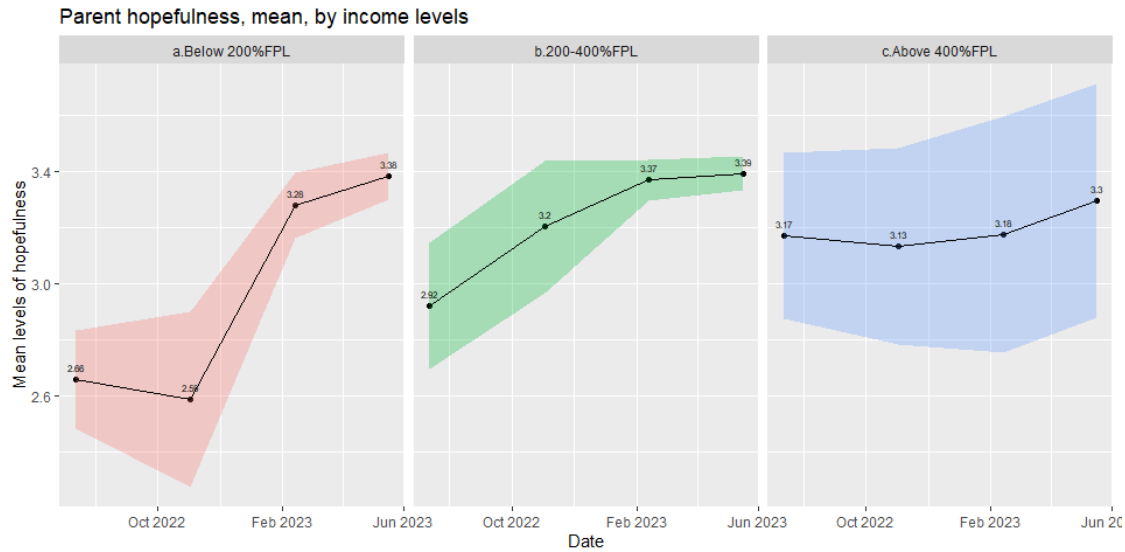

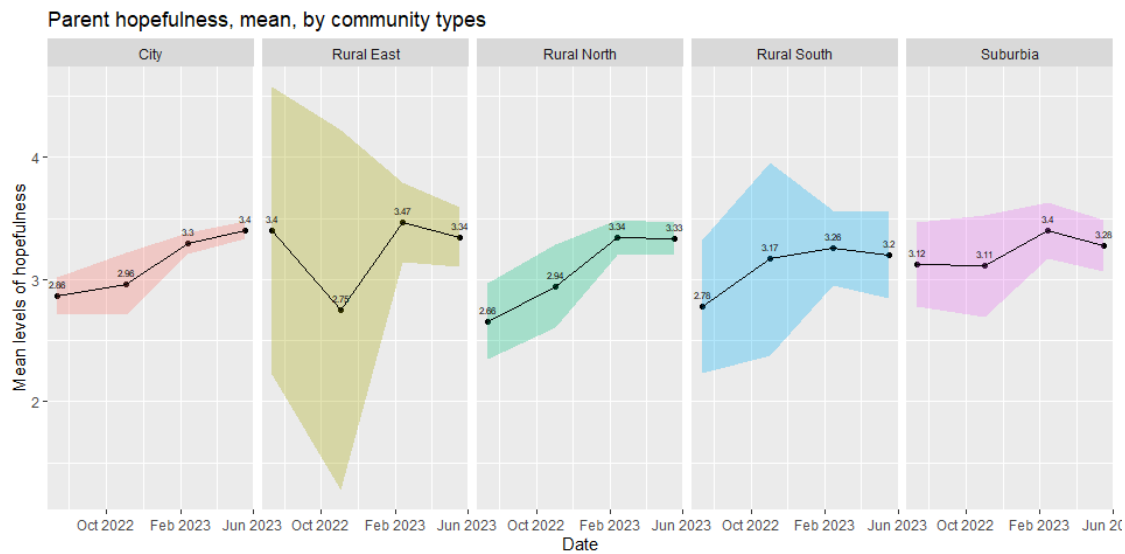

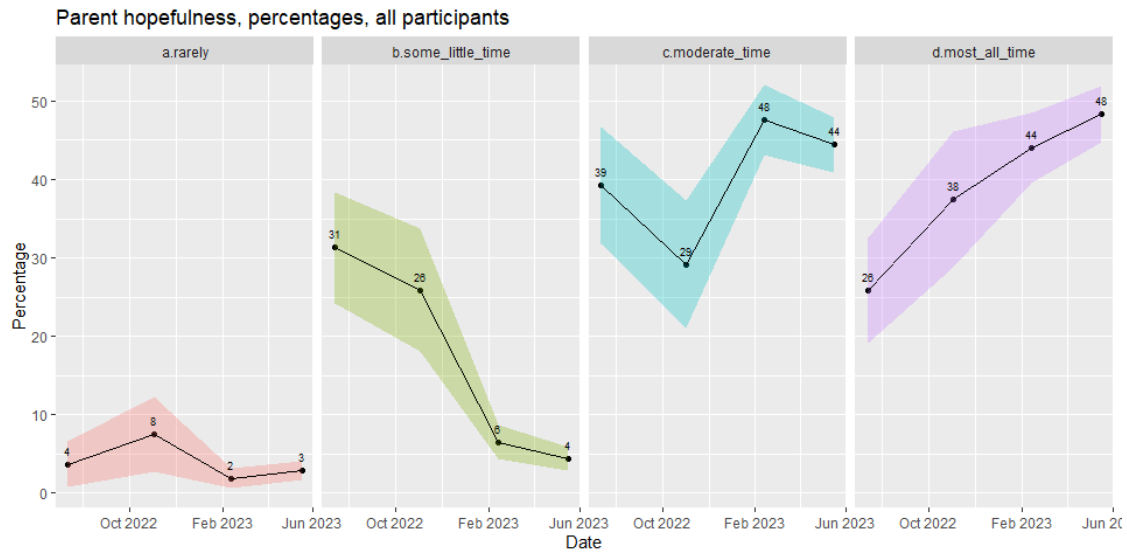

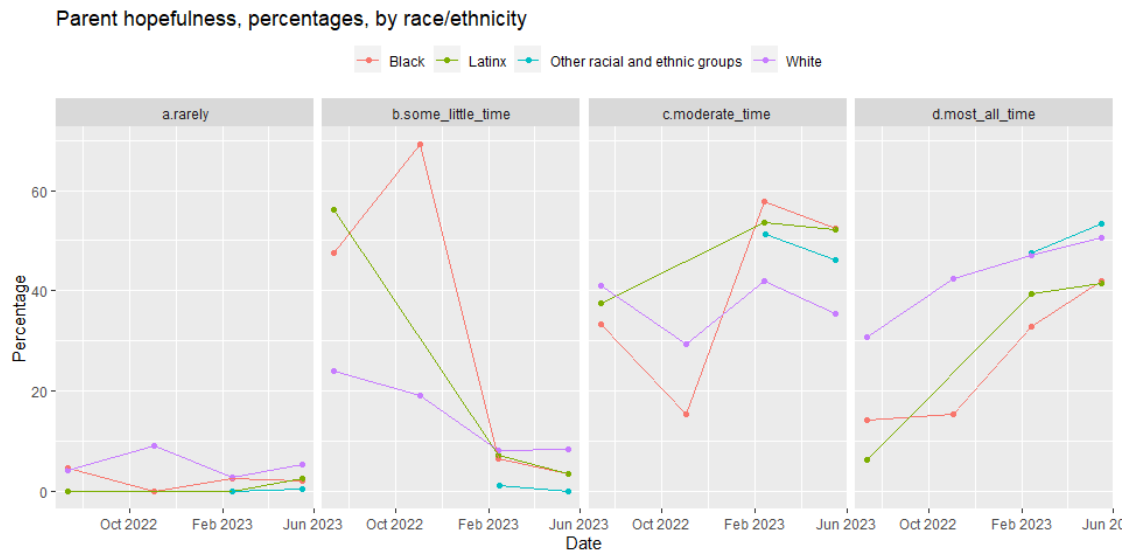

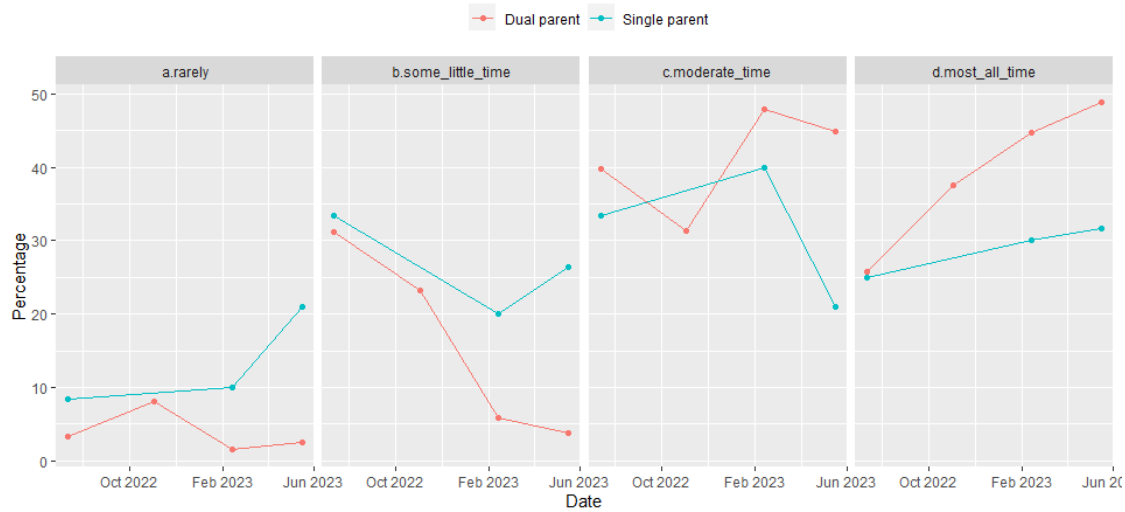

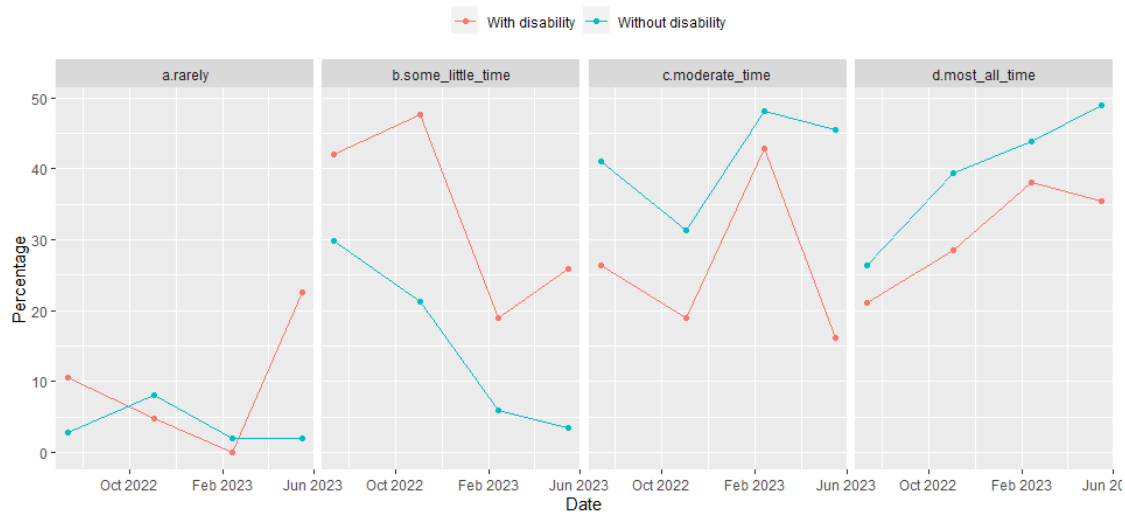
Parent hopefulness, percentages, by single-parent status

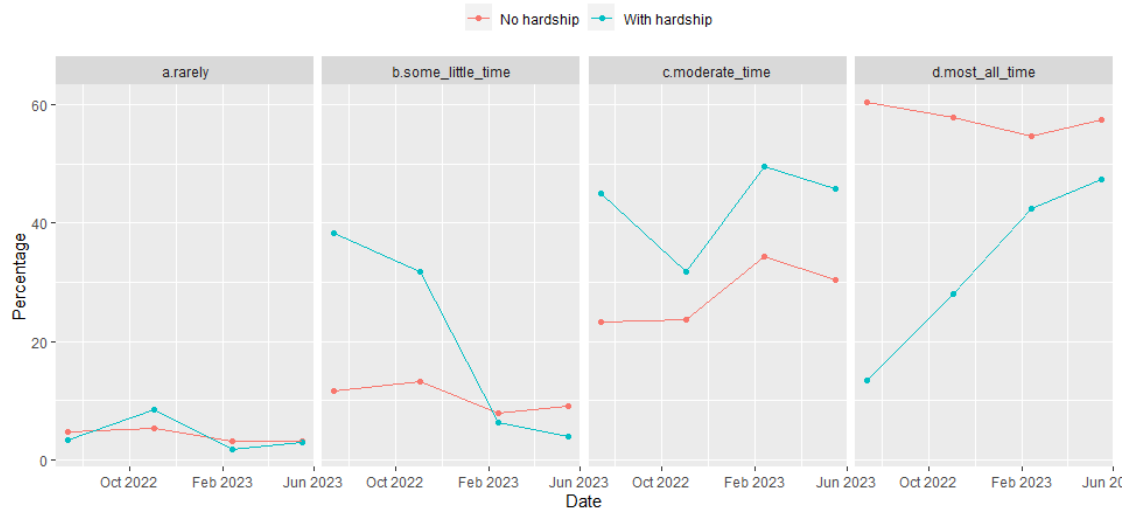

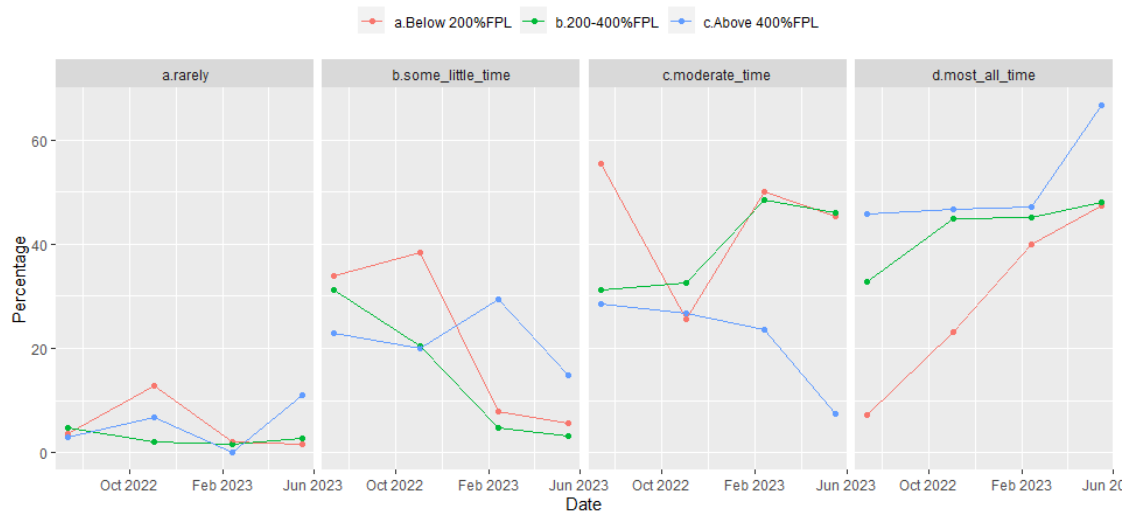
Parent hopefulness, percentages, by material hardship status
