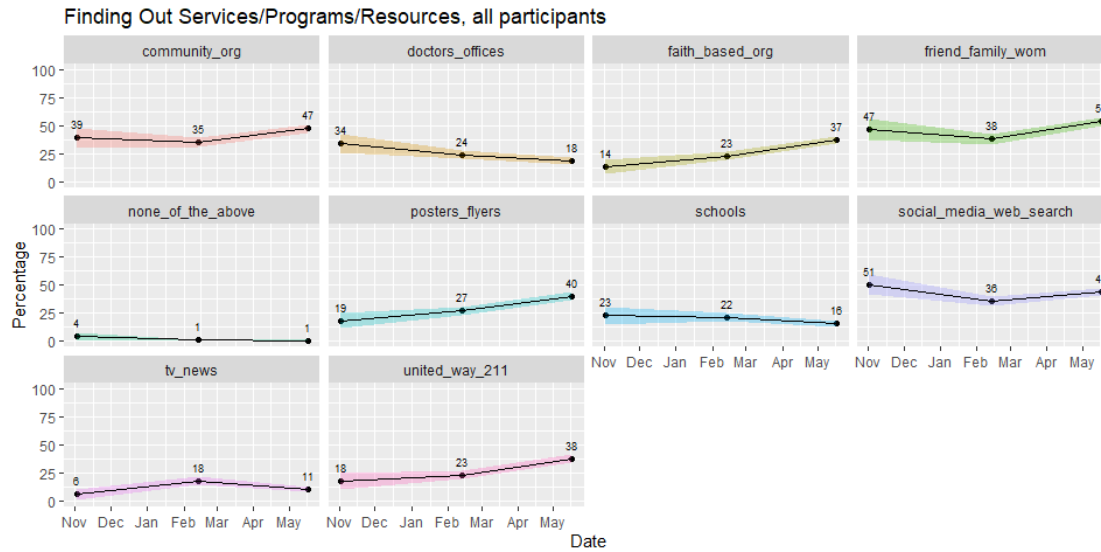

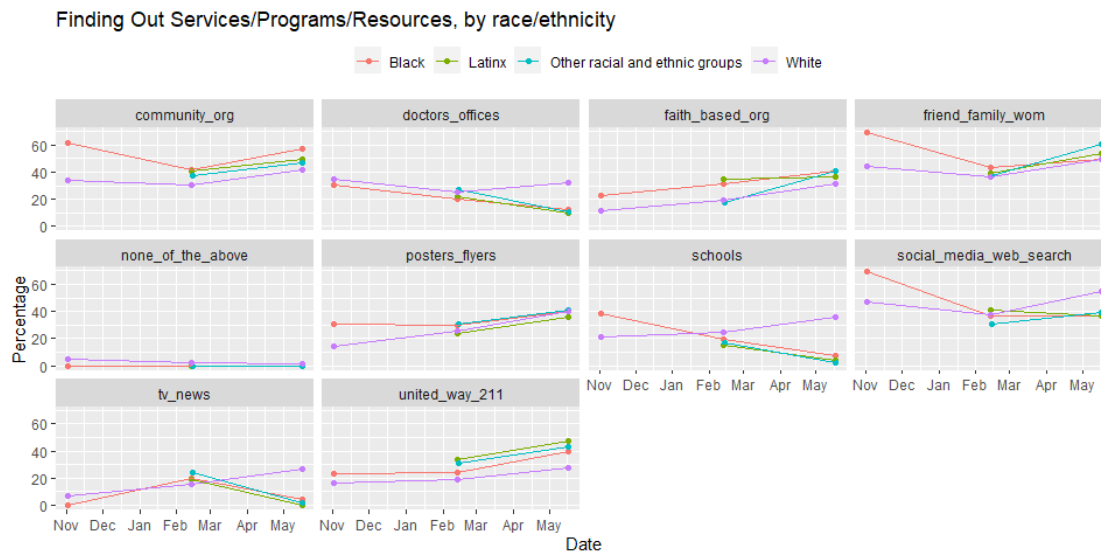

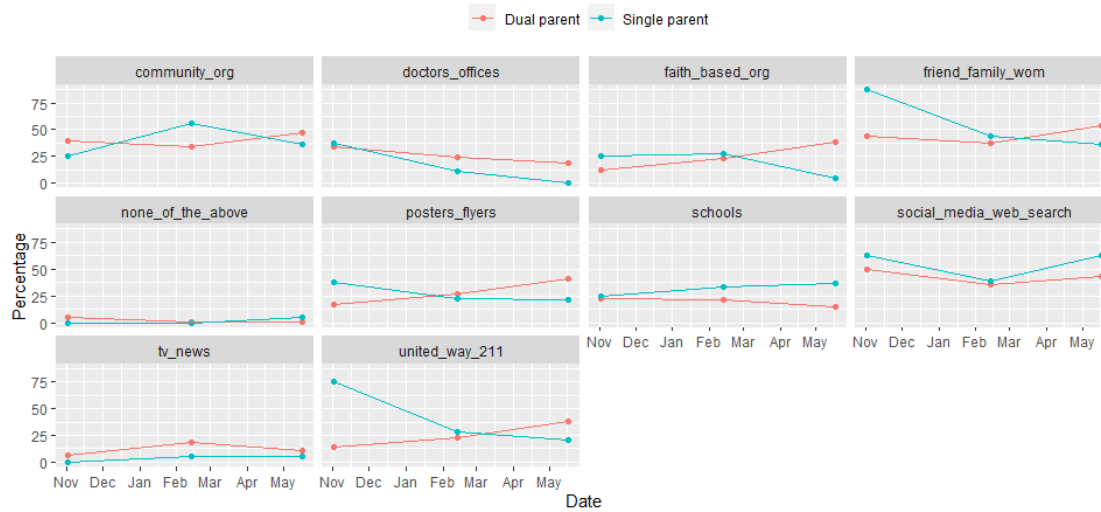

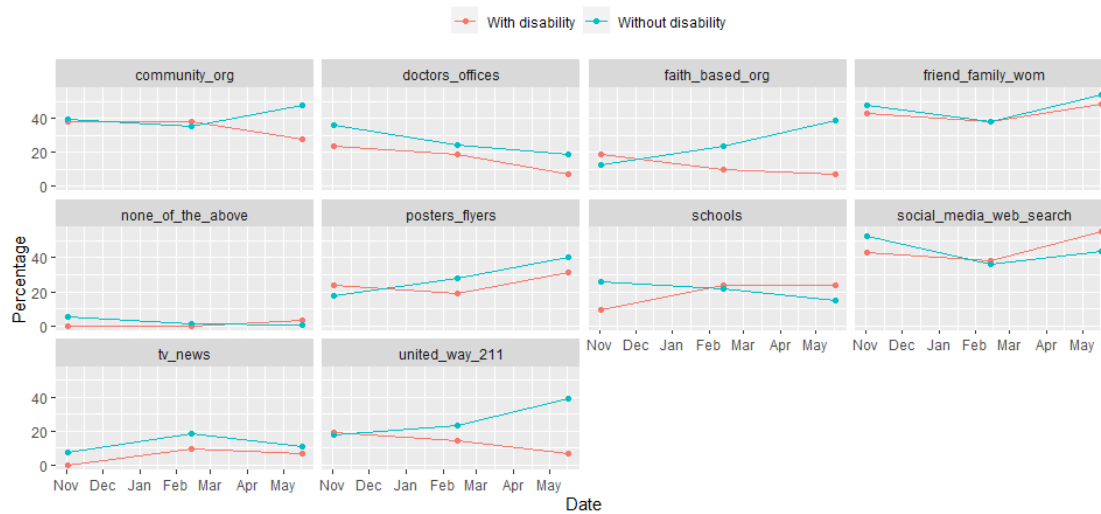

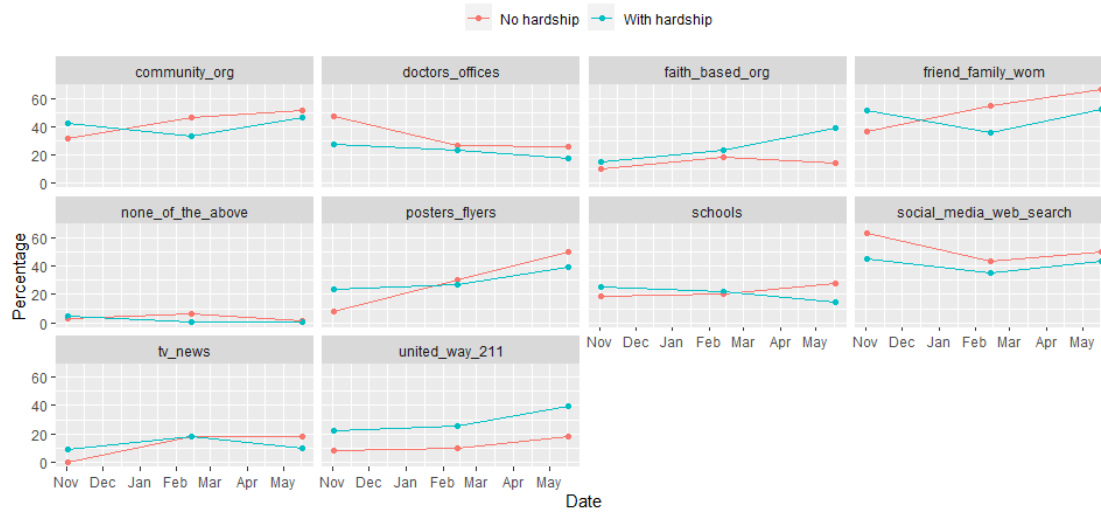

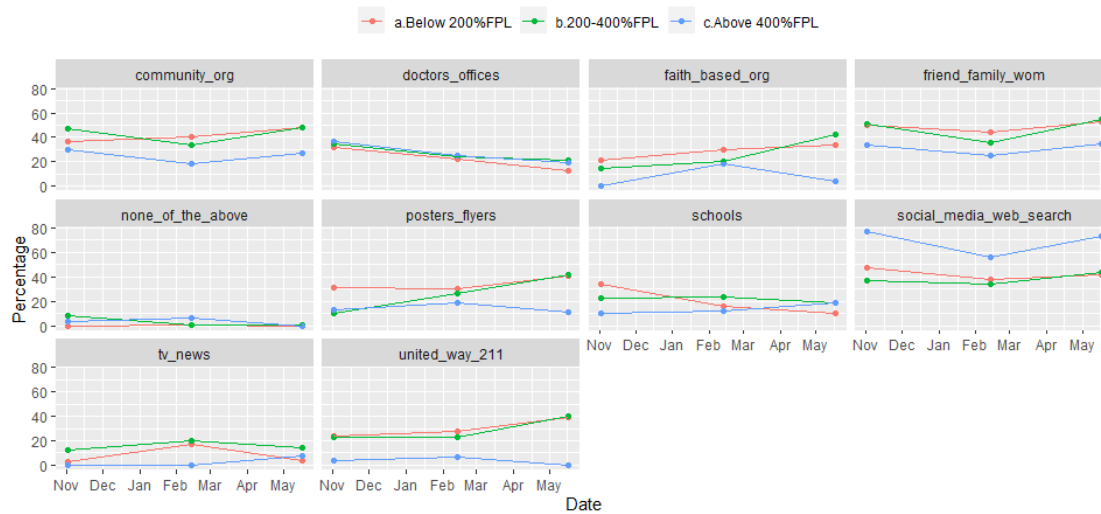

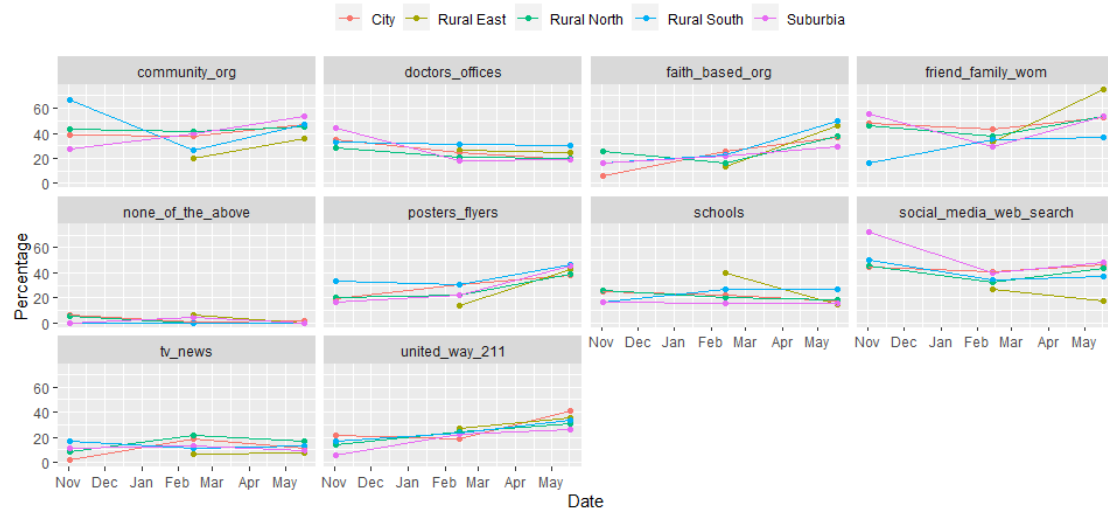

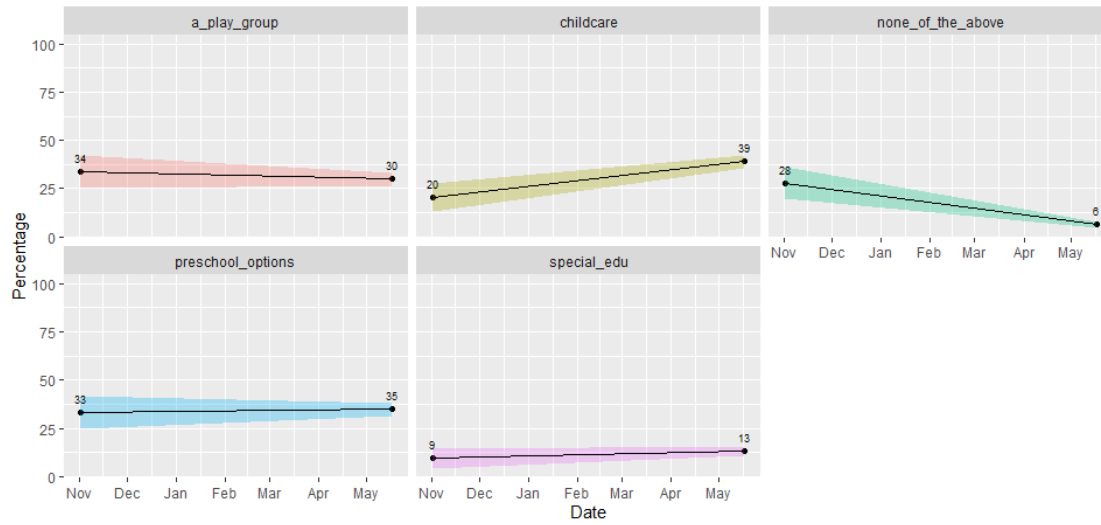

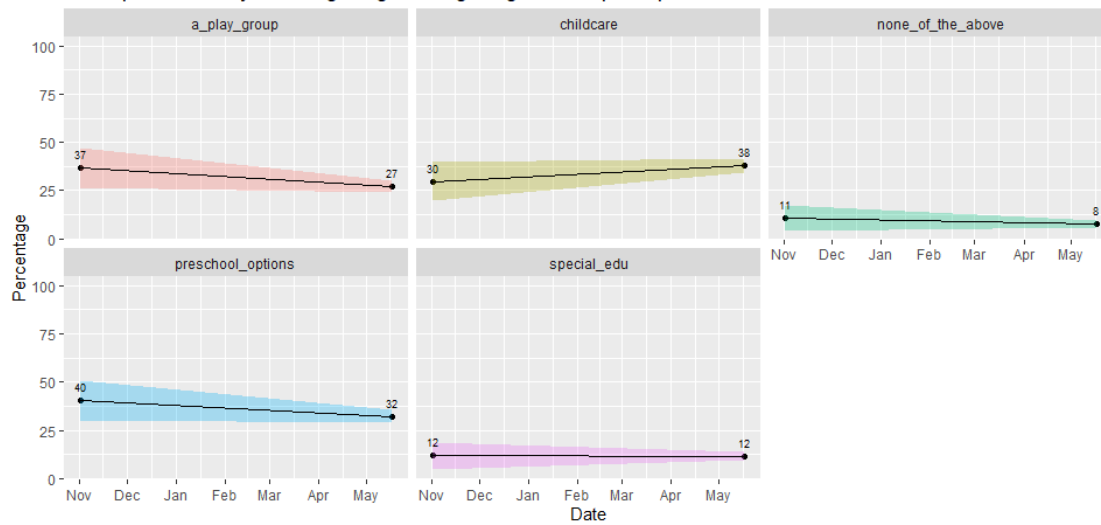

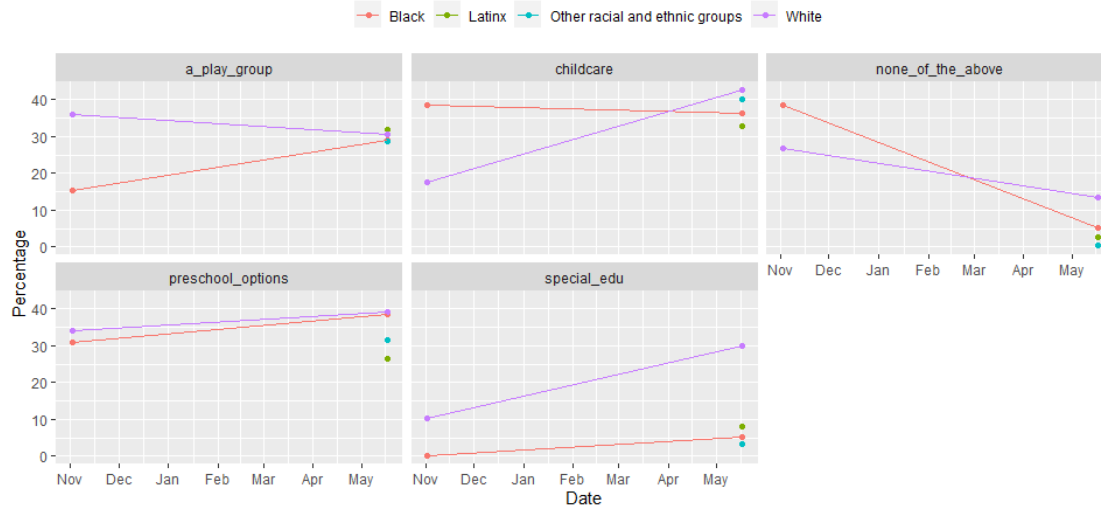

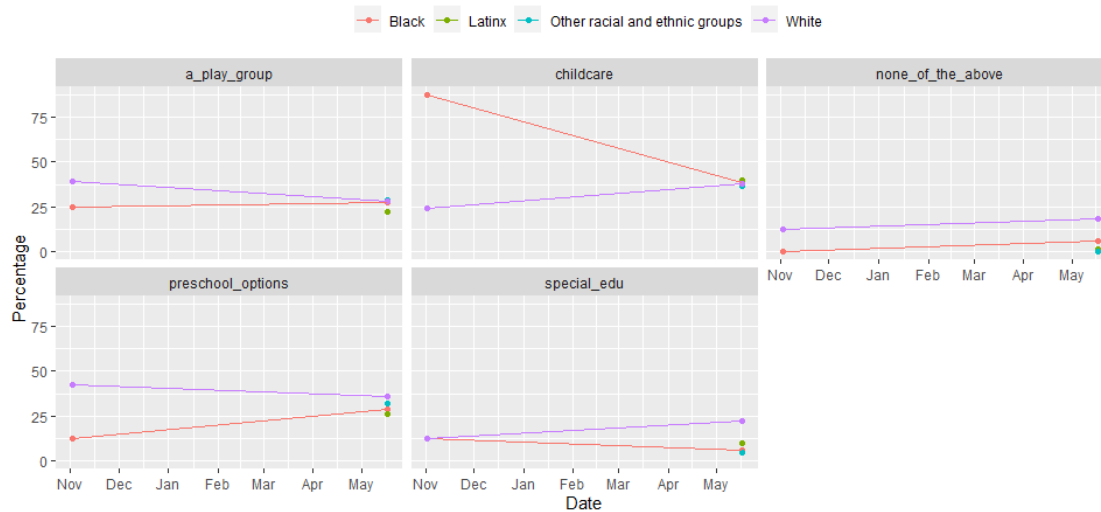

Receiving Information on Early Learning Programming Programs, by race/ethnicity



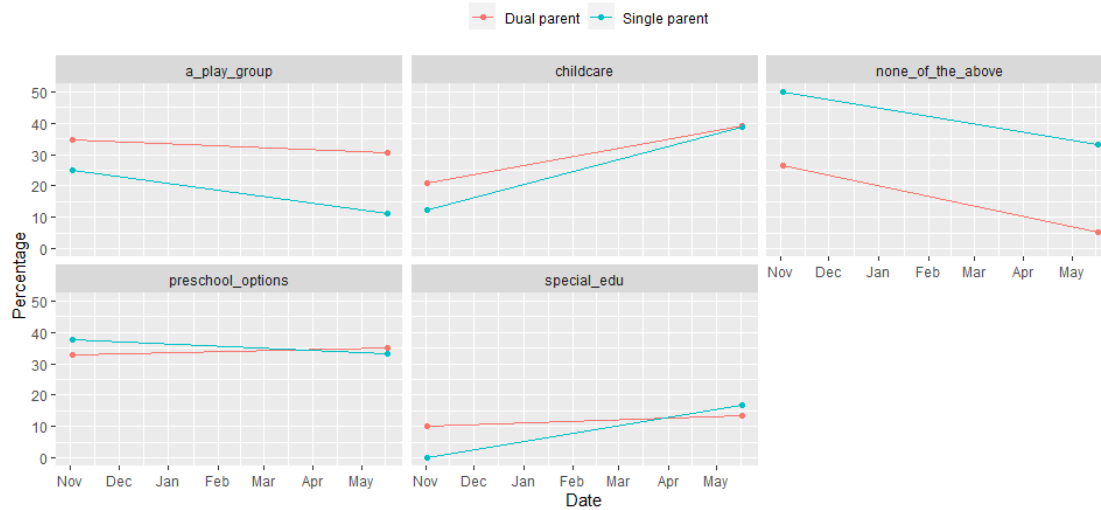

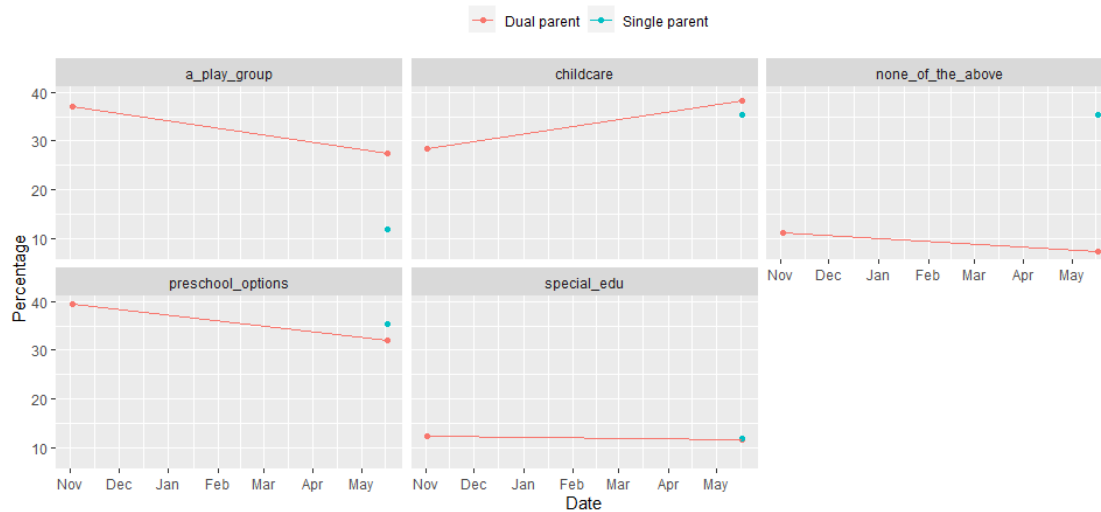

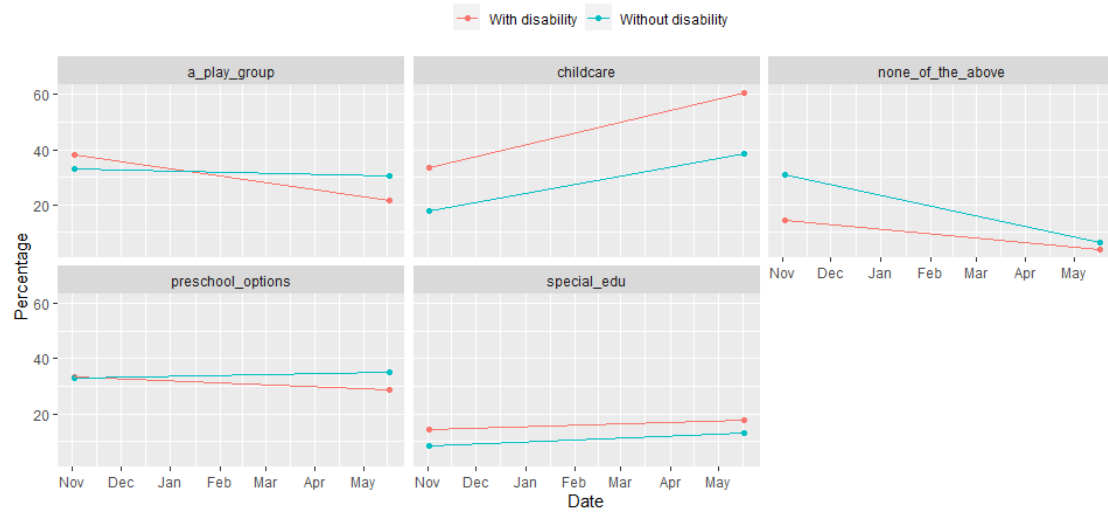

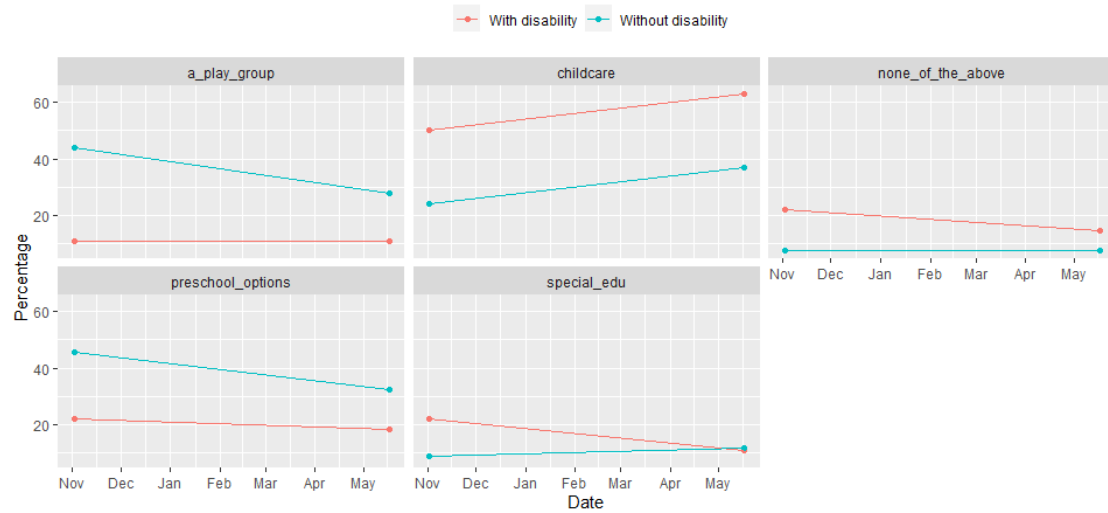

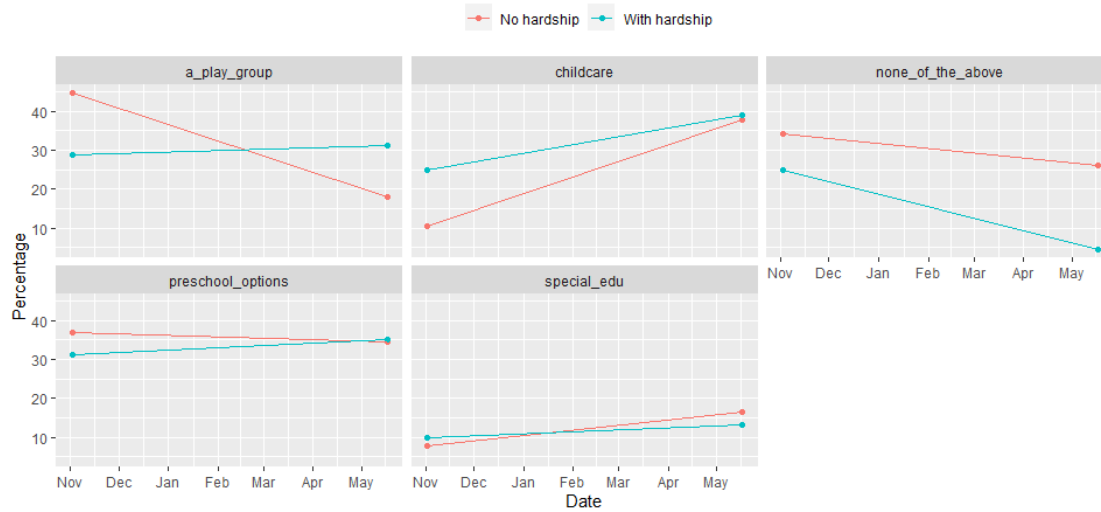

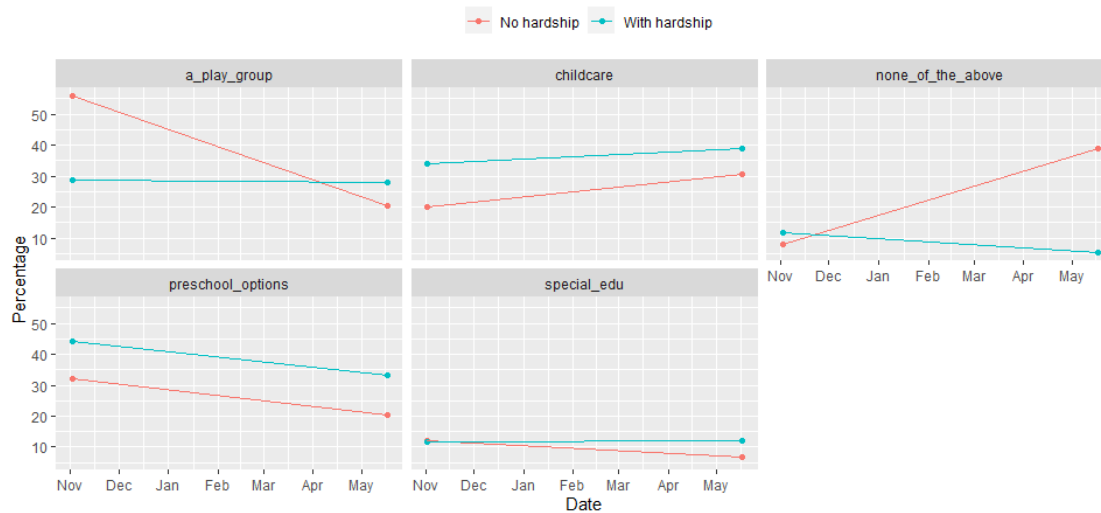

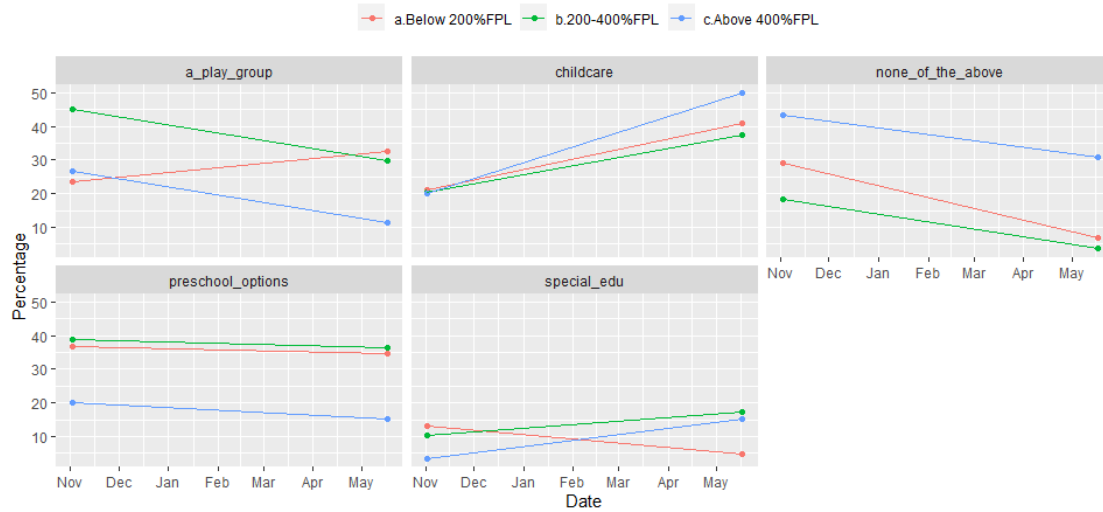

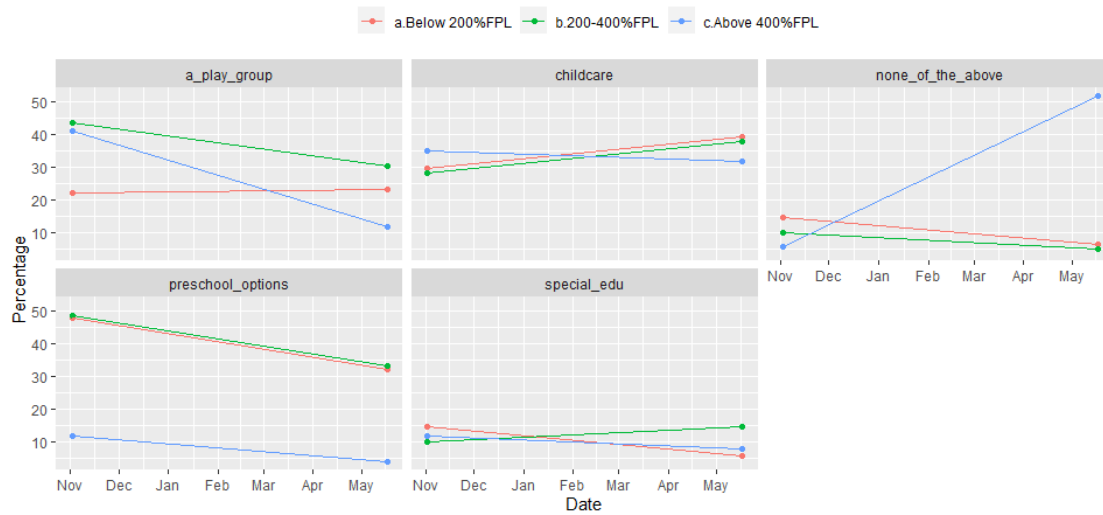

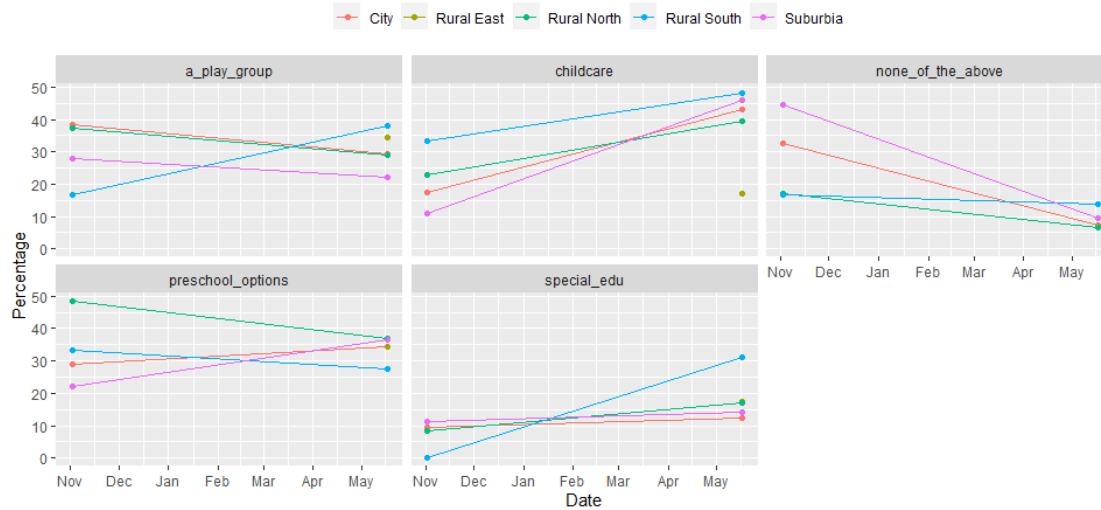

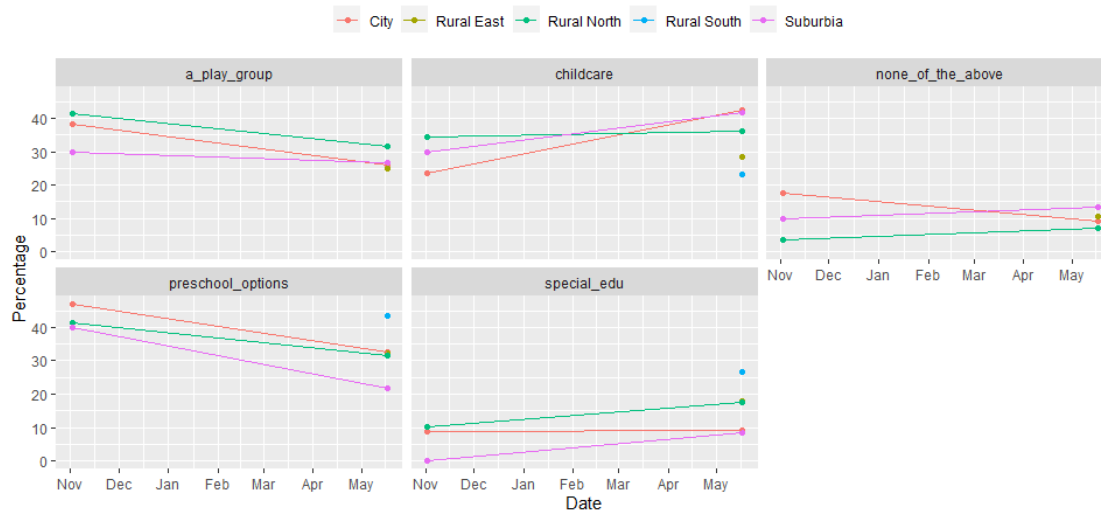

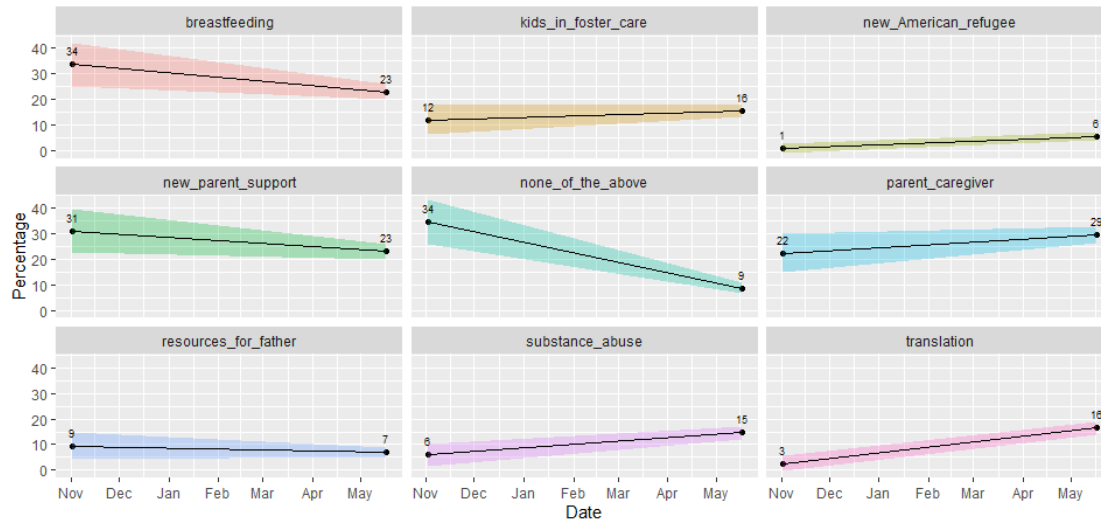

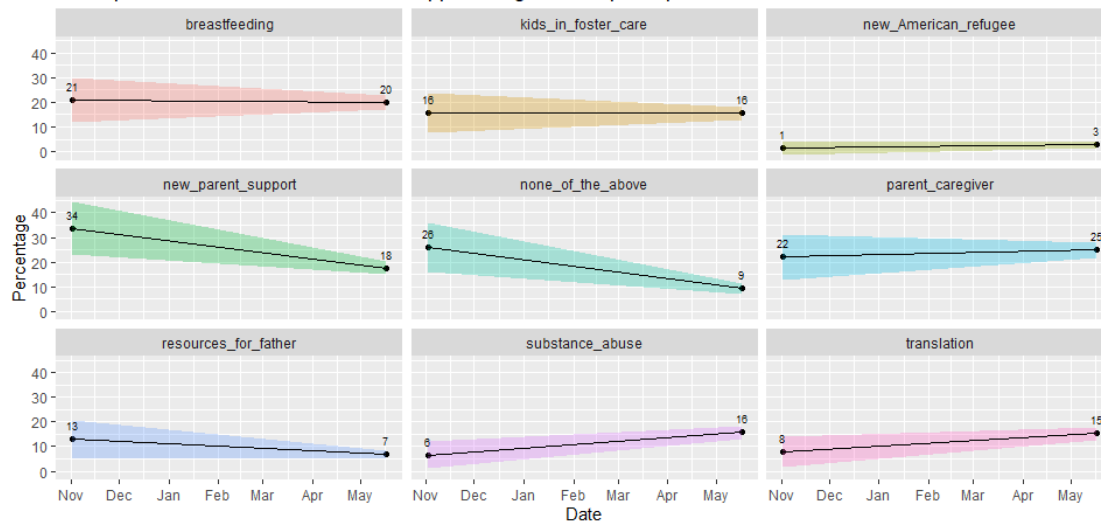

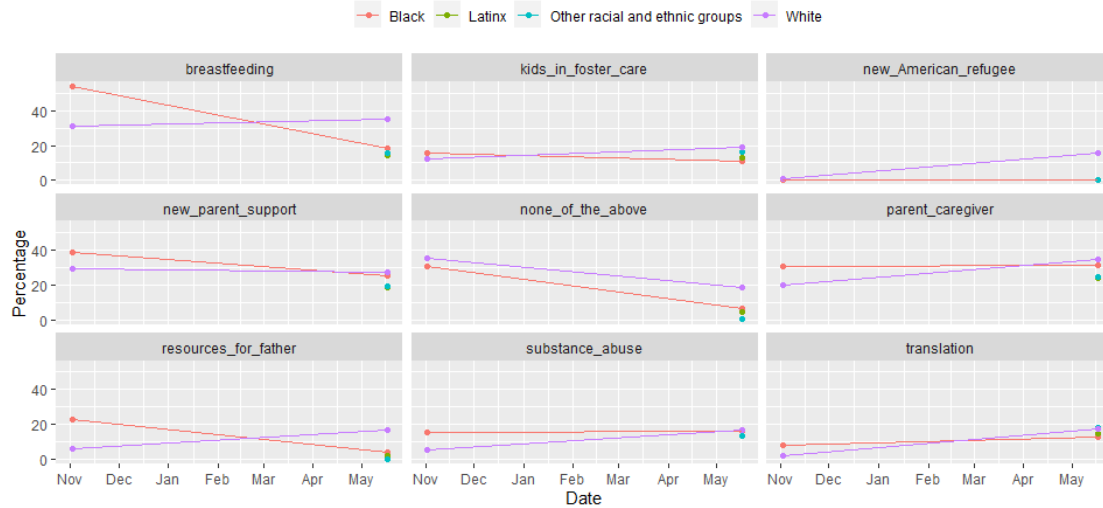

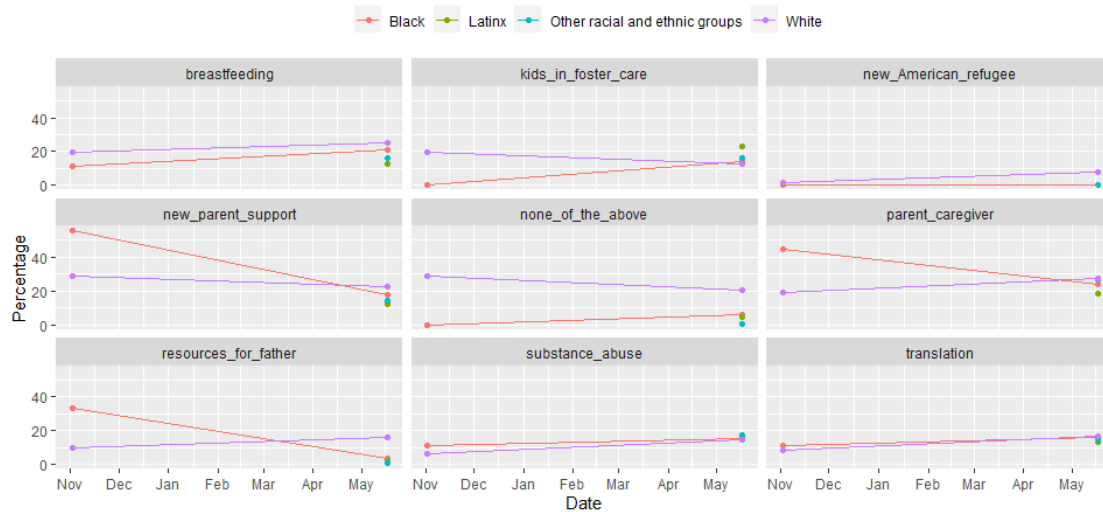

Receiving Information on Parent Education and Support Programs, by race/ethnicity



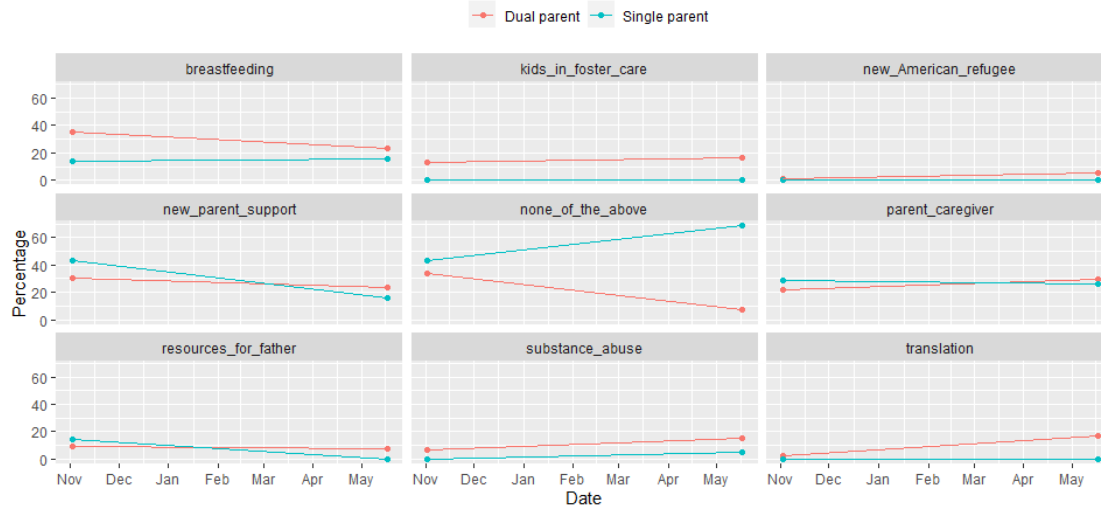

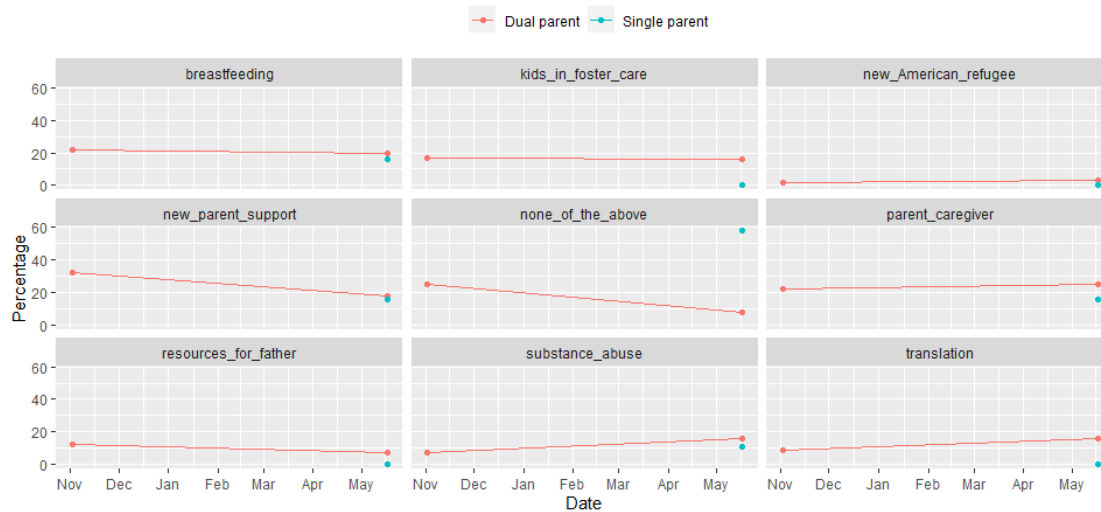

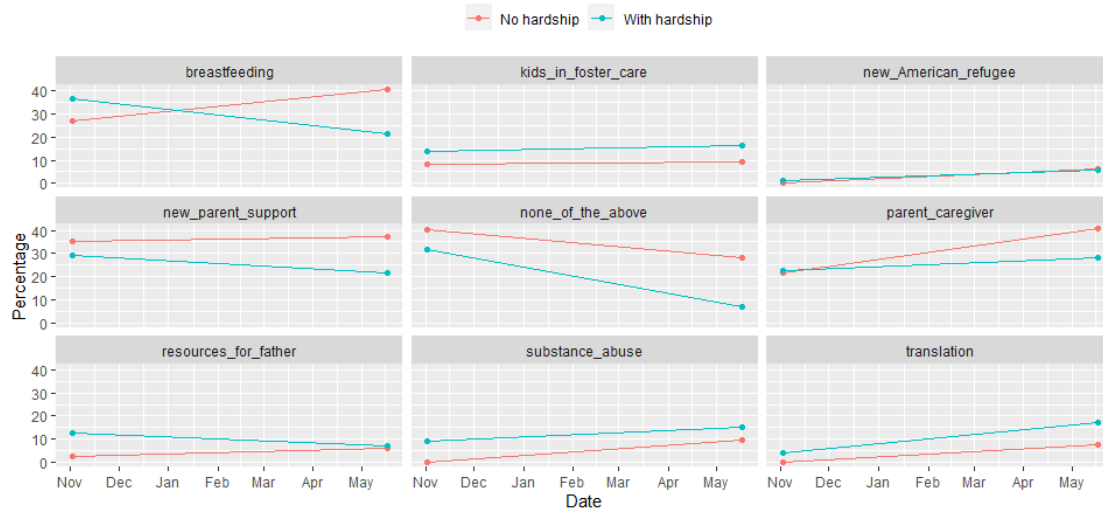

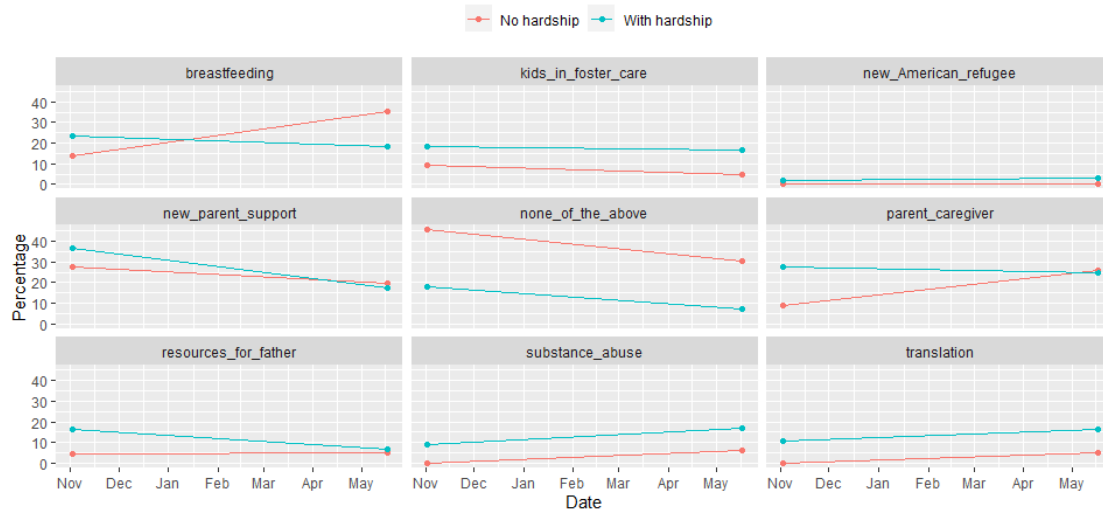

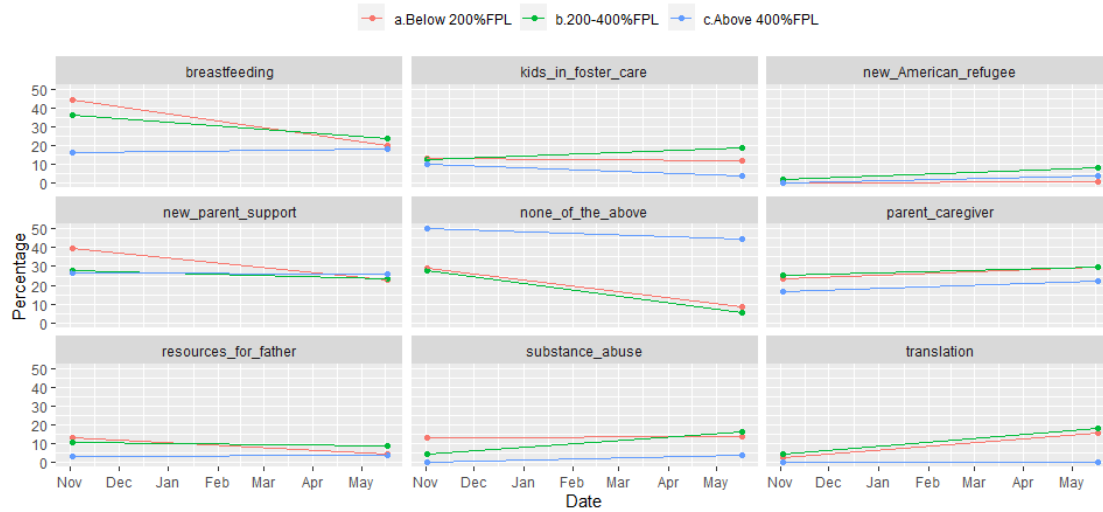

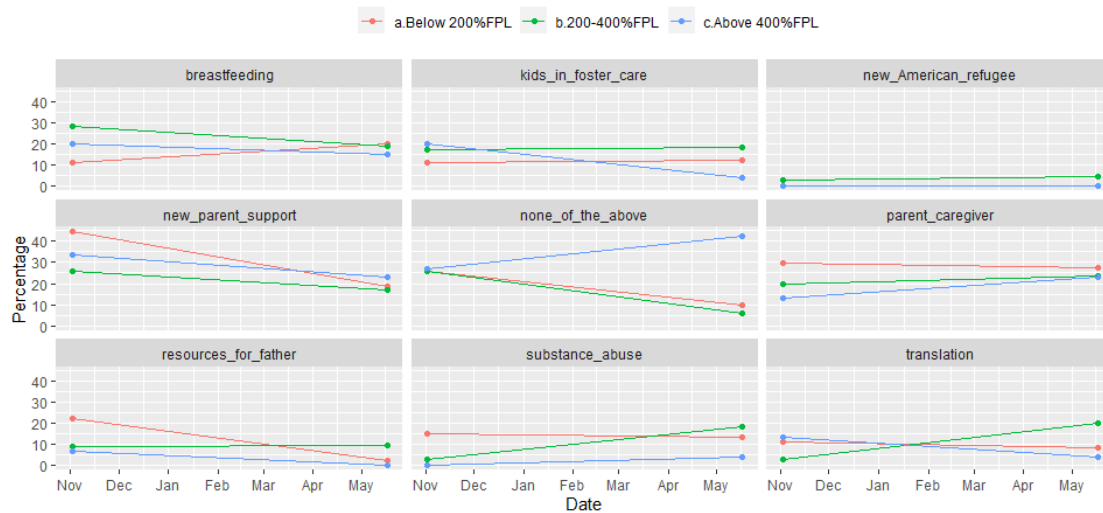

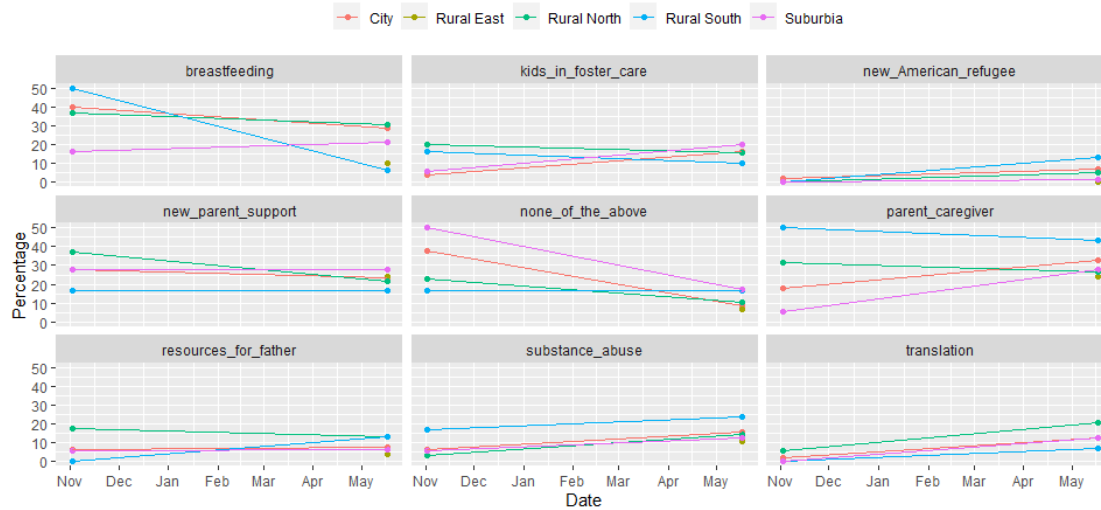

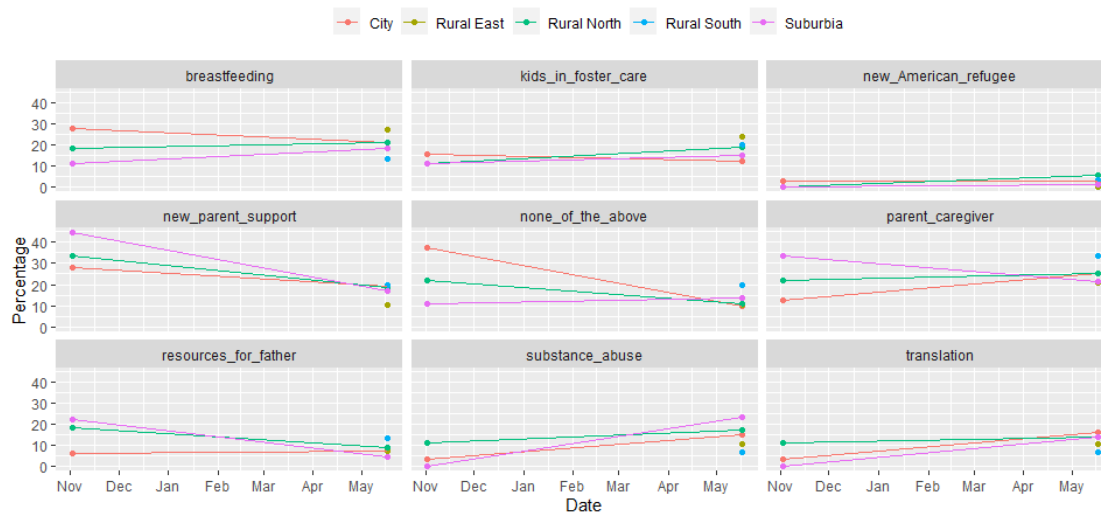

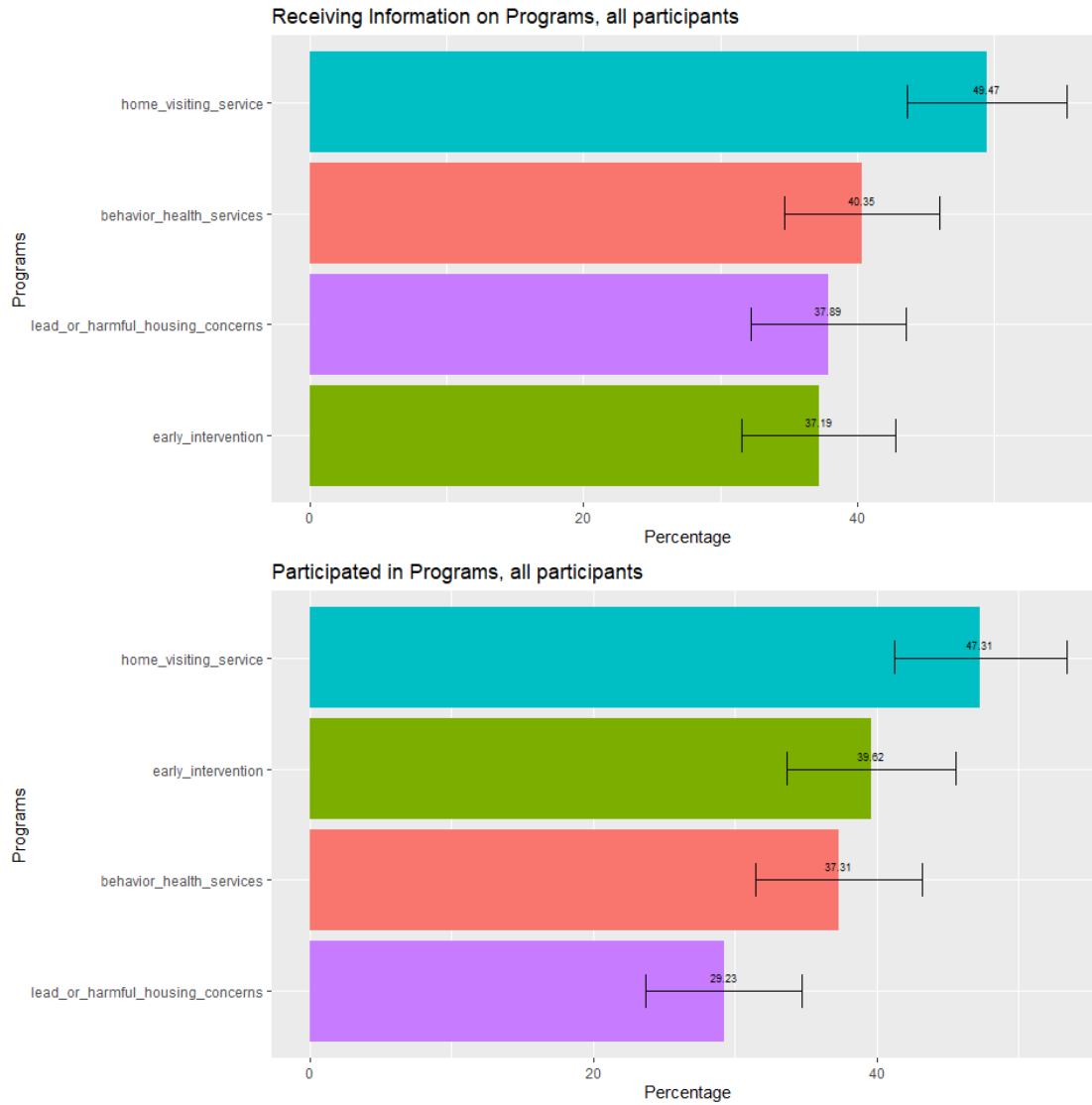

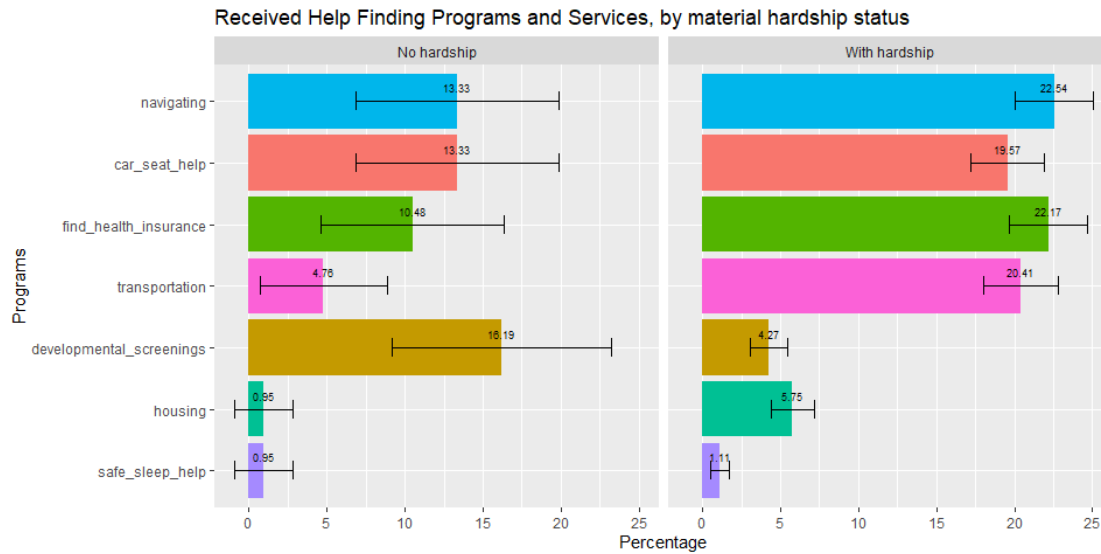
