

Ready by Five Early Childhood Millage

Resident Proposal Review Board Funding Recommendation Summary

Proposed for Approval by the First Steps Kent Board of Commissioners

July 27, 2023

The Ready by Five Resident Proposal Review Board (RPRB) met June 22-29, 2023 to review 45 proposals submitted under the following RFP opportunities:

- Outreach and Navigation Services
- Healthy Development Services
- Healthy Development Training
- Parent Education and Support Language Services
- Early Learning Services
- Parent Education and Support Services

The total recommended allocation for October 1, 2023 – September 30, 2024 is \$11,006,189.

This amount includes:

- On June 29, 2023, the RPRB recommended allocating \$8,900,511 that will fund a total of 34 services for the upcoming fiscal year.
- In 2022, the RPRB had recommended funding 39 services for a total of \$2,105,678 for services that are currently under contract through December 31, 2023. There is an overlap with contract dates due to the County changing their fiscal year start date to October 1 beginning this year. The contract start dates have been modified accordingly and are noted for each allocation.

The breakdown of funding recommendations FY 2023-2024 are as follows:

Please note: the allocations for January 1 - December 31, 2023 are provided for comparison purposes.

Outreach and Navigation

Ready by Five millage funding has allowed for the creation of an Outreach and Navigation network by developing a multi-agency strategy to reach and engage families in a coordinated way. This network serves as the "right door" for families to find available resources, information, and programs.

Outreach aims to increase the usage of early childhood programs and community resources by engaging future parents and families with young children who are not currently engaged in services or are unaware of services. As families are engaged, programs work to identify the needs of families through formal screening as well as conversation with the individuals served. As needs are identified, navigation will address barriers to accessing services, information, and resources to ensure families are successfully connected to referrals and information.

One agency will be selected to develop enhanced infrastructure that will provide up to date information about the current child care openings available in Kent County ensuring families are accessing available child care spaces. Programming in this area will leverage technology to foster better connections between families and child care providers. Agencies applying under this program type will develop an online "Platform" that will organize and provide access to information related to current child care openings in Kent County.
